The Bureau by airtel dated 11/15/71 has advised that the Bureau henceforth will utilize an Administrative Index to assist in making readily retrievable and available the results of Bureau investigations in subversive activities. The Bureau has advised this will be known as the ADEX and will consist of four categories, as follows:

Category I:

(1) All national leaders of revolutionary organizations whose aims and purposes include the overthrow and destruction of the Government by force and violence or other unconstitutional means, and individuals affiliated therewith who have demonstrated propensity for violence against the person rather than property or have received special training in sabotage, espionage, or guerrilla warfare or have engaged in underground type operations.

(2) Revolutionaries, though unaffiliated with any specific organization, who have demonstrated by acts or statements a propensity for violence, including acts of terrorism, assassination, or any interference with or threat to the survival and effective operation of national, state, and local Governments and of the defense efforts.

(3) National leaders of black extremist separatist organizations.

(4) Any individual who qualifies for the ADEX should be included in Category I if he is employed in or has access to a key facility.

Category II:

(1) Secondary leadership of revolutionary and black extremist separatist organizations. Secondary leadership would comprise, for example, regional, state, and local leaders who are involved in policy making in fulfilling anti-U. S. objectives of their respective revolutionary organizations and whose activities do not justify their inclusion in Category I.

(2) Active participants in furthering the aims and purposes of the revolutionary or black extremist separatist organization with which affiliated.

(3) Other unaffiliated revolutionaries who have demonstrated by acts or statements a propensity for violence against property rather than persons.

Category III:

(1) Rank-and-file membership in, or participation in activities of, revolutionary organizations within the last five years as evidenced by overt acts or statements established through reliable sources, informants, or individuals.

(2) Leadership or activist position in affiliated fronts of revolutionary organizations within the last three years as shown by overt acts or statements established through reliable sources, informants, or individuals.

(3) An individual who, although not a member of or participant in activities of revolutionary organizations or considered an activist in affiliated fronts, has exhibited a revolutionary ideology and is likely to seize upon the opportunity presented by national emergency to commit acts of espionage or sabotage, including acts of terrorism, assassination, or any interference with or threat to the survival and effective operation of national, state, and local Governments and of the defense efforts.

Category IV:

(1) Individuals whose activities do not meet criteria of Categories I, II, or III but who are in a position to influence others to engage in acts inimical to the national defense or are likely to furnish financial aid or other assistance to revolutionary elements because of their sympathy, associations or ideology.

This case is in a Category II status at the present time. All cases involving former Priority I and II, according to Bureau direction, will be reviewed within the next 30 days. The Bureau deadline in this matter is 12/18/71.

Certain administrative devices in handling the results of such review have been proposed to the Bureau, and you will be further advised as to how to report results. In the meantime, this case should be thoroughly reviewed in line with the above criteria, and you should be ready to report results when the administrative handling is resolved.

MARIO ROBERT SAVIO, a Priority II Security Index subject of the Los Angeles Division, resides at 19 1/2 25th Avenue, Venice, California, and is unemployed.

SAVIO was the leading spokesman and leader of the Free Speech Movement (FSM) at the University of California at Berkeley, California (UCB) during 1964 and 1965, and was arrested and convicted in connection with a FSM sit-in 12/2 and 3/64. Between 9/64 and 2/65 he associated with Communist Party, USA member BETTINA APTHEKER. In 1964 he spoke before a meeting of the Socialist Workers Party and a meeting of the W.E.B. DuBois Clubs of America.

[REDACTED]

During (u) 1964-1966 he participated in numerous civil rights and anti-war demonstrations. In 1/67 SAVIO signed a Student Mobilization Committee letter indicating he would be a sponsor of this organization. In 4/68 he spoke at a rally at UCB in support of the National Liberation Front. The 7/1/69 issue of "The Daily Californian," a newspaper published by the associated students at UCB, quoted SAVIO as describing capitalism as "obscene and lurid," and as stating we of the past industrial generation are natural communists.

In view of the lack of any recent activity on the part of SAVIO and the fact that he is not affiliated with any basic revolutionary group, it is recommended that this individual be downgraded to Category III in ADEX.

FD-400 was submitted for SAVIO on 10/29/71, and the next letterhead memorandum is due at the Bureau by 10/29/72.

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

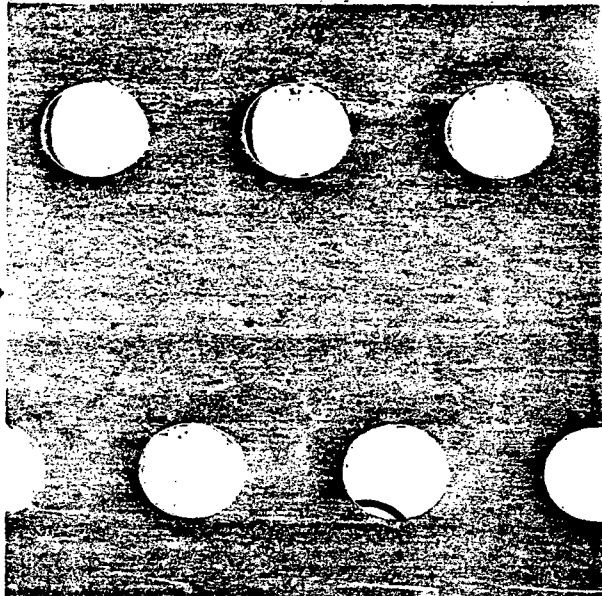
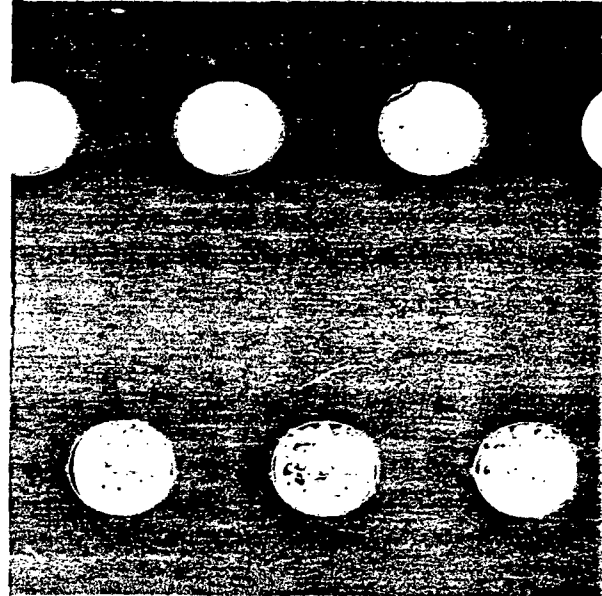

Activist of '60s Assails the Police for Their 'Hysteria'

BY MARIO SAVIO

It was around midnight three nights after the Friday evening shootout between the Symbionese Liberation Army and the Los Angeles Police Department that two reporters came to my apartment just as I was about to go to sleep. They wanted to do something to help save the life of Patricia Hearst. To my total disbelief, the reporters actually asked if I knew Patty Hearst's whereabouts, or if I could help make contact with her.

At first I viewed this midnight appeal as part of some bizarre fantasy. But once I had overcome my initial disbelief, I began to realize that this request had not occurred in a vacuum. It was no isolated incident but, rather, a direct product of the hysterical sensationalism now surrounding the entire saga of Patty Hearst and the SLA—a hysteria that easily could be directed at anyone who has been active in what the police and the press consider to be "the left."

This wave of hysteria has swept through and around all of us. The most dramatic and horrifying example of just what it can produce was seen coast-to-coast on prime-time TV on the evening of May 17. A tactical police assault team employed a strategy that led to what looked

like war. It was in this context that the police justified the horrible and excessive tactic of shooting or burning to death their "enemy"—all those who had taken refuge in that bungalow on 54th St.

Police officials argue that they had no choice, for they were faced with armed and dangerous terrorists; not only did they call on the suspects to surrender, but before opening weapons fire, they used tear-gas canisters in an effort to root out the occupants. It was only after receiving a great blast of gunfire from the house, the police tell us, that they returned the gunfire. In short—according to the police version—warfare was the only realistic or reasonable alternative.

~~But was this really so—or were the po-~~lice determined to stage a latter-day "public hanging?" Had the police decided to execute their enemies? Was there really no reasonable alternative to all-out warfare—or had the police consciously decided that they would take no prisoners?

As citizens' groups and area residents have pointed out, a more humane and practical alternative was, in fact, available. The alternative would simply have been to wait out the suspects—by clearing the area surrounding the house as a way to protect residents of the neighborhood and, perhaps, by calling in family members and friends of the suspects to plead for their surrender.

A double message emerges from the lurid spectacle of that Friday evening war:

—To the potential opponents of the status quo, the police seemed to be saying, "Don't get too far out-of-line or you'll be dealt with mercilessly."

—To the broader community, another message was given: The police are strong enough to protect ordinary, law-abiding citizens from the irrational violence of criminal terrorists. In short, "Stick with us and we'll take care of you."

That second message, however, has been strangely contradicted by events. The anti-SLA hysteria had not begun with the shooting of Oakland's black school superintendent, Marcus Foster—arguably an ordinary, law-abiding citizen. It was the political kidnaping of the daughter of one of San Francisco's wealthiest families that incited the subsequent hysteria.

Without in any way endorsing the actions of the SLA, we must face squarely the fact that the police can be counted on "to protect and to serve" only the wealthy and powerful. Unfortunately, this conclusion is strengthened by the location of the shootout in a poor community of blacks. A natural question arises: Would the police have endangered lives and destroyed property so recklessly if the SLA suspects had been caught hiding in Beverly Hills or Bel-Air?

In their total rejection of reason and moderation—in choosing brutal and excessive methods—the police have gone far beyond their proper functions as protectors and servants of the public. Instead, they played the roles of judge, jury and executioner. Is this not the very essence of a police state?

Once the potential for a police state exists—once the police machinery has been created and is poised for action—then few explicit orders regarding methods need be given. All that is necessary is simply to unleash special police forces, such as L.A.'s "swat squad," and to promote a general atmosphere that sanctions their special activities.

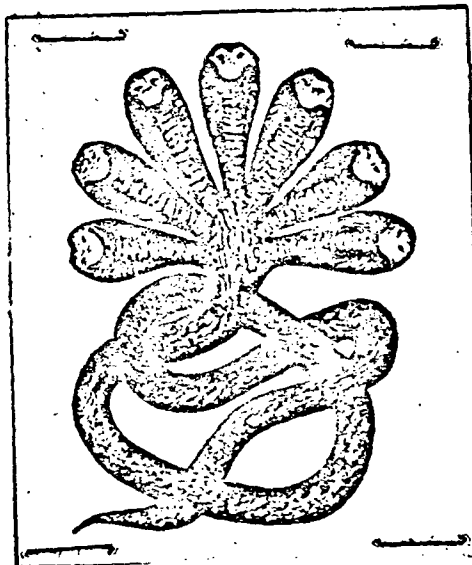
Given the mere existence, in major U.S. cities, of these highly developed, well-funded, paramilitary police machines, then the means exist to restrict, to sabotage, to intimidate and, bluntly, to destroy all of us who are working for needed and meaningful social change.

For propaganda purposes, the police defined the SLA as a band of criminal terrorists, against whom the ordinary citizen needed to be protected. But to all actual or potential opponents of our social system, the message was very different. In their actions, as opposed to their propaganda, the police saw the SLA much as the group defined itself—as part of a revolutionary political movement that posed such danger to the established order that it could only be dealt with by merciless slaughter rather than by apprehension, trial and, possibly, conviction.

All this, larger than life on television, was a preview of 1984. This was the kind of thinking that led to the tapes, the "plumbers," the Ellsberg break-in. Such tactics have been used to date largely against those branded "left" or "radical." But as the examples of Greece and Brazil make clear, not to mention Nazi Germany, the first victims are always the "radicals"—but soon the net widens to include any and all whom those in authority come to dislike.

The clearest indication of where all this may end can be found in Richard Nixon's published list of political enemies. Very few on that list can be considered "radicals"—the vast majority are peace advocates, civil rights leaders, noted journalists, Democrats of all political shades, even dissident Republicans.

If Americans accept the war of May 17 as a legitimate and reasonable method of law enforcement, they will have gone a long way toward condoning—indeed promoting—the onset of a police state.
