

Niger | Crises Overview

The country is affected by multiple on-going crises in 2019: 6 from 8 regions are facing an emergency in severe acute malnutrition and more than 1 million people will require emergency food assistance in the country during the next lean season. People living in conflict affected areas will be in food crisis for the third consecutive year. Since beginning of the year the security situation has deteriorated, leading to an increase in forced displacements in Tillabéri and Diffa region.
