


Editing image information on WikiCommons

To add a caption, scroll down below the image and click edit, then accept the terms. Add your caption in any language, then click Publish changes.



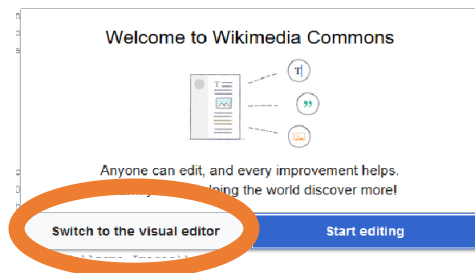
To correct existing information or add more specific details, click the edit button to the left of the search bar.



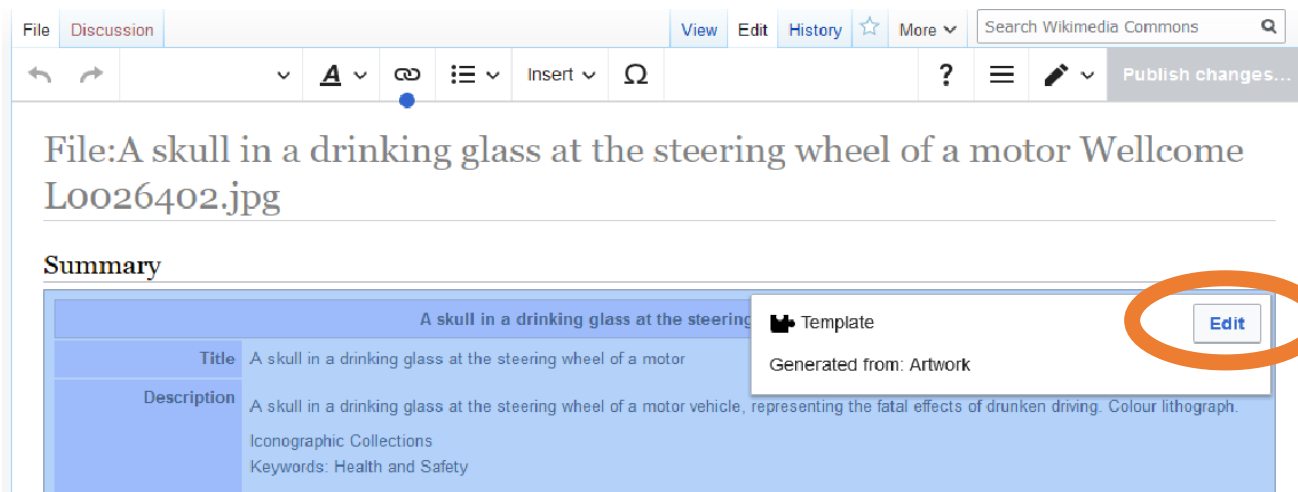

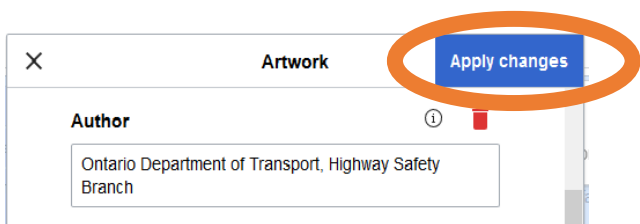
Switch to Visual Editor.
