1. I have no idea of the underlying purpose behind the request of the Doc Res Section for the files in question. However, in view of the international implications of the information, I do not believe the decision to release it to the Doc Res Section rests with us.

2. It is my understanding that the files, as such, have not been forwarded to Washington. In that connection, an SRI ID-34-497, which was forwarded to the Scty Div for action in early August has been answered by the Scty Div (based on information contained in the subject files) and the reply has been forwarded to Washington as a short basic document.

3. I believe we should query G-2 D/A on the subject, advising them of the request of the Doc Res Section, and advising them of the existence of the files which were used in support of our answer to the foregoing SRI from G-2 D/A, requesting:

- a. Whether the information should be released to the Doc Res Section,
- and
- b. Whether Washington desires a microfilmed copy of the files.

1. On several occasions in the past, contents of Security Courier Material has been required to be compromised as a result of Top Secret Control officers removing wrappings addressed to an individual by name or to a particular section. This is particularly true of material addressed to Document Research or Mr. Aurell. To avoid any future violations of this nature, officers opening envelopes or packages will examine the address on each wrapping prior to opening. If wrapping is addressed to a particular section by name no further wrapping will be broken or removed and material as is will be receipted for by section or individual whom it is addressed to.

2. The outer covering on all material received for Document Research may be addressed in many different ways, and in all cases can not be identified from the outer wrapping. Their addresses are found on the second wrapping, therefore, extreme precaution must be taken in removing wrapping from the material.

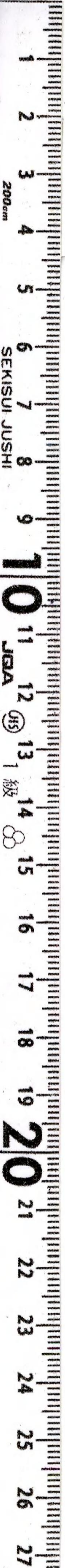

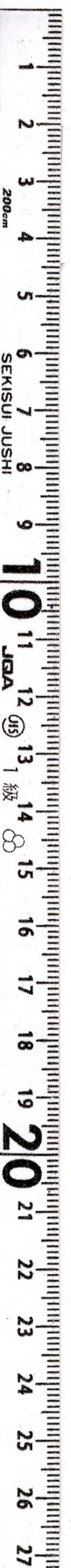
