II. SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE:

On 19 March 1944, two Americans and some Filipinos were taken from the Japanese garrison at Dagupan, Pangasinan, to the garrison at Alaminos, Pangasinan. The following morning, the town chief of police saw the bodies of the two Americans and seven Filipinos in a grave within the garrison premises. The Americans had been beheaded and the Filipinos had been bayonetted (R 4, 7).
