1. In response to directions contained in Letter Hq. I Corps AG 400.12E, dated 20 Sept. 1946, Subject: Violation of Procurement Policy, paragraph 4b this Headquarters initiates the following letter to explain the preemption:

2. In October 1946 the latrine facilities in the CIC billet in Gifu were in a condition that, had they not been repaired immediately, would have impaired the the health of the men quartered there. Leakages and improper flushing were conducive to a sanitary condition directly opposite to that specified in Army regulations covering latrine sanitation. During this period conditions approached a stage where sanitary conditions actually prohibited the use of the latrine facilities. Under such conditions, immediate repair was undertaken and a procurement demand was forwarded to cover these repairs.

SUBJECT: Termination of Procurement Responsibility

1. Reference: Section III, Circular 86, Headquarters Eighth Army, 22 May 1947.

2. Pursuant to the above reference, the IV Procurement District has taken over procurement responsibility in the I Corps area. The following offices have been opened to handle procurement transactions in the areas indicated:

- a. Kobe Branch for Hyogo Prefecture.
- b. Osaka Branch for Nara, Wakayama and Osaka Prefectures.
- c. Kokura Branch for Kyushu Region.
- d. Kyoto Branch for Tokai Region plus Fukui, Shiga and Kyoto Prefectures.

3. All centrally issued demands (JPNZ, JPNR, JPNO and JPNK) have been forwarded to the appropriate branch office prior to 1 August 1947, relieving the military government teams of procurement responsibility on such demands.

4. Eighth Army termination teams have visited the following prefectures, taken up local procurement records and have given the commanding officers a "Statement of Termination", which contains a statement that the office is considered closed and also contains instructions for disposition of procurement records which may be received in the closed office after departure of the termination officer:

Kinki Region

Fukui, Nara, Shiga, Wakayama

Tokai Region

Gifu, Ishikawa, Mie, Shizuoka, Toyama

Kyushu Region

Kagoshima, Kumamoto, Miyazaki, Nagasaki, Oita, Saga

5. A termination team is presently operating in Aichi Prefecture and will relieve that team of procurement responsibility upon completion of its activities.

6. The procurement responsibility in Fukuoka, Osaka, Hyogo and Kyoto Prefectures had been assumed on 1 July by the IV Procurement District Branch offices in each of said prefectures. While the teams have no further procurement responsibility as such, they are still responsible for action required where a team is the receiving unit. For example, a team occupying real property is responsible for the execution of a procurement receipt (form GPA 2), forecasting future requirements for operation and maintenance, taking up the item on property records, exercising security control, and executing procurement releases (form MGP 7) on return of the property to Japanese control.

7. Vehicles have been issued to Fukuoka, Osaka, Hyogo and Kyoto Teams for the exclusive use of the Procurement Branch Offices. Other teams are responsible for providing vehicular transportation to procurement expeditors when required in their prefectures upon proper and prior request. Other assistance will be rendered procurement expeditors when required and available.

8. All requests, inquiries and communications from all other units concerning procurement procedure will be referred to the proper Procurement Branch Office.

2. The above Procurement Demands will apply to all U.S. Army owned floating equipment. It will also cover the repair and maintenance of all indigenous craft on Procurement Demand, found abandoned, salvaged, and craft legally possessed by the unit, which have been reported under the provisions of Section V, Circular 290, Headquarters Eighth Army, dated 21 October 1946. Emergency repairs to any other floating equipment will be referred to this headquarters for prior approval. Normal repairs requested by other commands will be referred through this headquarters to Eighth Army, and SCAP for approval.

3. These demands provide only for routine or emergency services for maintenance and repairs to floating equipment not to exceed normal maintenance and repair requirements. (Reference is made to Army Regulation 55-505, 5 February 1947). These demands do not include or authorize rehabilitation, conversion, renovation or alteration of vessels, the original description of which was furnished on data sheet WD AGO Form 55-26, from Navy or other Government specifications or from the original specifications obtained from other sources, without prior approval of this headquarters. Also excluded is the furnishing of supplies or services not normally procurable from appropriated or non-appropriated funds.

4. Requirements for vessel repair facilities should be included on the Forecast of Miscellaneous Indigenous Procurement.

5. It will be noted that procurement demands for vessel repair have been furnished each prefecture, and anyone desiring such services as are covered by the demand should contact the designated receiving officer of the prefecture.

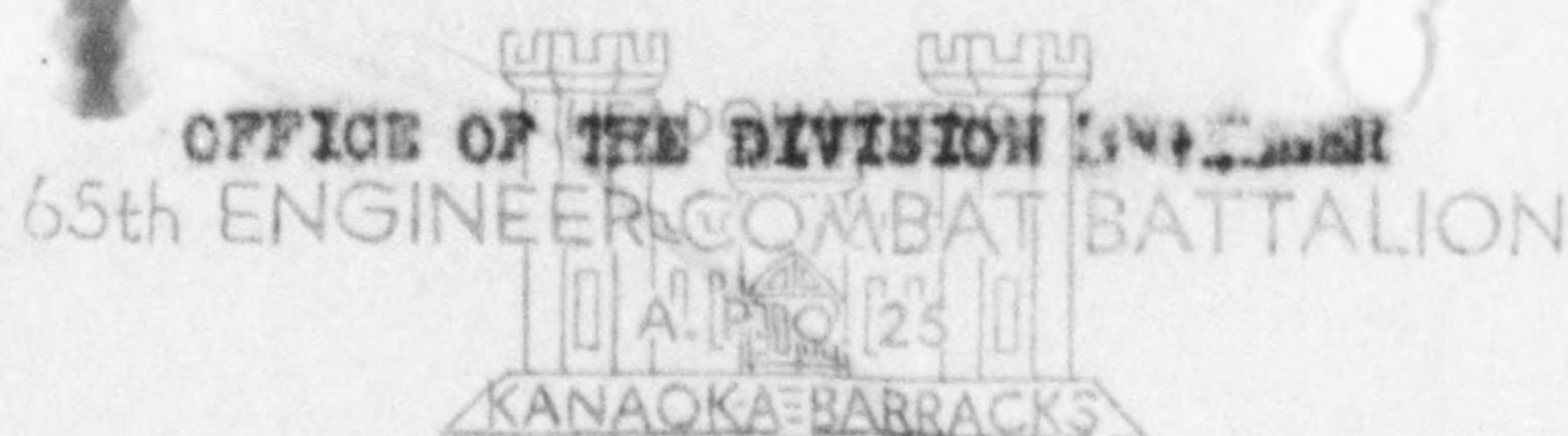

1. According to our records monthly procurement receipts through the month of October have not been received by this office. These receipts are due at this office on the fifteenth of the month following the month covered by each receipt. However, due to the habitual late submission of these receipts by your office, the following procedure will be initiated upon receipt of this letter.

a. If procurement receipts have not been submitted so as to reach this office by the 15th of the month following period covered by receipt, a letter of explanation for tardiness in submission will be forwarded to arrive at this office no later than the twentieth of the month following receipt period.

b. If procurement receipt is not received at this office by the last day of the month following the month covered by receipt, this headquarters will initiate action with the Prefectural Office.

2. In many cases an insufficient number of copies of final receipts have been submitted to this office. Partial receipts are to be submitted in ten (10) copies. Final receipts are to be submitted in eleven (11) copies. In either case, the Japanese contractor should receive two of these copies after processing by this office. However, should insufficient number of copies arrive at this office in the future, the Japanese supplier (or contractor) will not receive two copies from this office, but only those remaining after the required copies have been filed and forwarded by this headquarters.

TO : Commanding General, 25th Infantry Division, APO 25

1. Attention is invited to inclosed letter, Headquarters Eighth Army, dated 17 February, subject same as above.

2. You are directed to accomplish the survey requested therein for all units of the Occupational Forces located within your area of responsibility with the exception of those located within the limits of Post Number 40 (Metropolitan Kobe), Post Number 4 (Metropolitan Kyoto), and those assigned to the Air Force or to BCOF.

3. A report of this survey will be submitted to reach this headquarters not later than 13 March 1947 and will include the following:

a. A statement that all procured and surrendered property and supplies are properly accounted for in unit property books and that real estate has been entered on appropriate records.

b. A statement that all property for which no further requirement is anticipated, and all supplies for which no definite future need can be foreseen have been released.

c. A list of real estate of any kind which is not presently being completely used, but which is being retained for future requirements, with a statement in each case setting forth complete justification for the proposed retention.

d. A list of all supplies and real estate to be returned to the Japanese Home Ministry as a result of this letter.

4. Attention is particularly directed to the fact that this survey involves not only procured property and supplies but also enemy surrendered installations, property, and supplies.

5. You are further directed to initiate necessary action under provisions of letter, this headquarters dated 10 September 1946, subject, "Violation of Procurement Policy", to effect the immediate clearance of all improper procurements revealed by this survey.

2. Attention is invited to reference a, above, which requires the return to the Kome Ministry of supplies and facilities not required by the Occupation Forces, and references a and b above, which respectively prescribe the procedures for return of surrendered and procured facilities and supplies.

3. The following is quoted from a letter from the Commander-in-Chief, Far East, for your information:

"1. Several cases have recently come to the attention of the General Headquarters, United States Army Forces, Pacific, where the requirement for facilities has ceased after requisition but action to release these facilities has been delayed. During this interval, their rental value has been an unnecessary charge against the cost of the occupation.

"2. It is desired that action be taken to insure the prompt release of unused facilities for which no further requirement is anticipated. Clearance will be obtained from General Headquarters, United States Army Forces, Pacific, prior to releasing requisitioned facilities located in the Tokyo area."

4. It is desired that a thorough survey of all Japanese supplies and real estate under your control be made, to include both those taken over as property of the former Japanese Army and Navy and those obtained on procurement demand, to verify that all such supplies are properly accounted for in unit property books and that such real estate has been entered on appropriate records.

COPY

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Property for which no further requirement is anticipated and supplies and property for which no definite future need can be foreseen should be released.

5. It is further desired that a report of the results of this survey be made to this headquarters by 15 March 1947, listing all supplies and real estate returned or to be returned to the Home Ministry as a result of this letter. Where real estate of any kind is to be retained in anticipation of future requirements but which is not now being completely used, the report will so state, stating in each case the reasons for the proposed retention.
