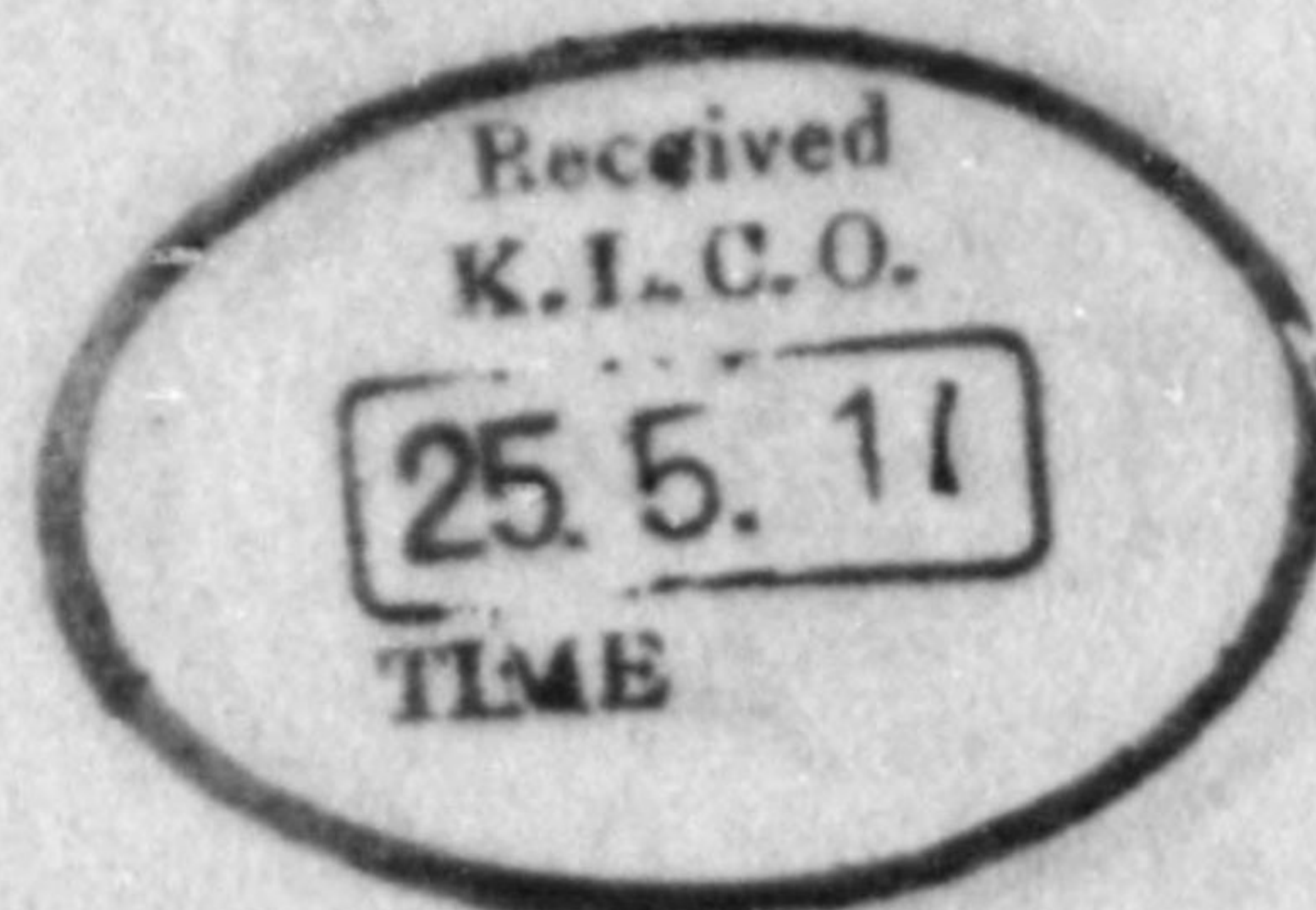

### Parasite Prevention Program

#### 1. Examination

We are going to take two model areas from among the towns and villages where there might be exceptionally large number of patients with parasites. In the areas, physical examination, microscopical examination for human waste and parasite control will be carried out for three months one time during the months of August, September and October for one area and another time covering June, July and August for another area.

#### 2. Sanitary education

Posters, pamphlets and leaflets will be prepared or purchased and distributed to the general masses during the Parasite Prevention Week to be carried out in October 1950 with the object of giving education for scientific idea of the prevention.



## VD Prevention Program

1. In the blood test, 380 people will be earmarked in monthly average at every health center; 21 % of them will be examined in 1st quarter period of the year, 26 % in 2nd quarter, 30 % in 3rd quarter and 23 % in last quarter with total earmark of 50,000 people in the whole prefecture.

2. Physical examination will be carried out in line with article 10 and 11. The enforcement of article 11 is represented by carrying out the examination for three people a time and 36 times a year at the average rate of 3 times a month.

3. In the examination on the infectious sources, it is earmarked that 12 people will be examined in average a month at every health center. Or 28 % of 1,500 people who are earmarked for the examination for a year will be examined in 1st quarter part of the year, 24 % in 2nd quarter part, 26 % in 3rd quarter part and 22 % in the last quarter part.

4. Medical treatment will be carried out for the forcible cases which are classified in our program into 160 people for hospitalization and 100 for coming from their home.

5. As for sanitary education, VD Prevention Week will be carried out in September and in every one of other months of the year, two times of lecture in average will be held.



## Epidemic Prevention Program

1. Following is the periodical immunization to be carried out in April 1950 and henceafterward:

Diphtheria:	approximately	100,000	persons
Typhoid:	"	825,000	"
Periodical Vaccination for Small Pox:			
	approximately	110,000	"
Whooping-cough:	"	110,000	"

Extraordinary immunization will be carried out against epidemic typhus or rickets, if necessary.

2. Examination will be carried out on such unsanitary homes and facilities where lice and something like that might be found. DDT spray will be intensified for them usually as a means of epidemic typhus prevention.

3. Examination on infectious cases

(a) Examination on typhoid and paratyphus cases and on their family.

Human waste will be examined for 102 cases of typhoid and paratyphus and their 500 family members during the period between 1 January 1949 and 31 March 1950.

Examiners: Local Hygienic Laboratory and Health Centers furnished with examination system.

Timing: June and July 1950

(b) Examination on food-establishments.

17,000 trade men of the sort will be checked in the prefecture.

Examiners: Local Hygienic Laboratory and Health Centers furnished with examination system.

Timing: May 1950

4. Moving pictures and lectures on sanitation.

To expect thorough execution of the preventive



immunization, further enlightenment and dissemination of the purport of the preventive immunization will have to be intensified. In addition to disseminate the knowledge of epidemic diseases during the periods prior to or in the period of prevalence of the infectious cases on digestive organs, the sanitary movies and lectures will be shown or made in whole of the prefecture.

Series of execution: 44 times at four places in every area of health centers.

Timing: June to August 1950.

3. General project on dissemination of sanitary idea.

The preceding part of sanitary education project will be focussed on the "Intensification campaign on Prevention of Legally Designated Diseases and Environ Sanitation" which will be launched during July and August 1950. The subsequent period of the same project will be focussed on each prevalent period either for smallpox or epidemic typhus, but far-reaching dissemination on the preventive immunization will be carried out throughout the year. In addition as a means of dissemination, to the movies the cloth-signs over the street, posters, leaflets and slides will be prepared and distributed as well as utilization of newspapers and radio. Furthermore, the Prefecture will work for exchange of sanitary informations for health centers, cities, towns and villages as well as for distribution of educational materials on sanitation. It represents our acceleration program of sanitary education for every separate area.

Immunization for diphtheria will supposedly be finished by the end of June 1950, if adequate supply of Toxisoid be made.

Typhoid: earmarked: 825,000 personnel

The immunization will be carried out in May and June 1950.

Periodical Vaccination: earmarked: 110,000 personnel

The immunization will be carried out in May and July 1950.

Whooping-cough: earmarked: 110,000 personnel

On obtaining necessary amount of vaccine the vaccination will be carried out around October 1950.



## Tuberculosis Prevention Program

## 1. Diagnostic examination

On the basis of preventing the infection of the tuberculosis by discovering the cases in early period, diagnostic examination will be carried out through the year toward the easily infectious groups such as waitresses (10,000 personnel), plant workers (10,000) and school pupils and children (10,000)

## 2. Guidance on cure treatment.

This aims at our guidance which will be made all year round by our circulating calls on the patients who applied for their tuberculosis case, and especially for poverty-stricken patients, we shall give them nourishment at free charge at a time of our call to help them in that respect.

## 3. Sanitary education.

On this, we will make or purchase various types of posters and leaflets especially in the "Tuberculosis Prevention Week" as a means of disseminating the idea of prevention and they will be distributed to health centers, cities, towns and villages as well as to general families of the patients.

## 4. Check on effectiveness of BCG.

Effectiveness of dry vaccine and its reaction will be examined to obtain the basic materials contributing to intensification of effectiveness of the vaccine, prevention of reaction which might happen and improvement of the skill of immunization. Such research has been made by Utsunomiya & Imaichi Health Centers since 1949 fiscal year but same research will be continued also in this year.

## 5. Training course on tuberculosis

The first series of the training course for improving method of the prevention will be prepared in April 1950 for the Roentgen practitioners of health centers and the second series will follow up in September 1950 for health centers, sanatoriums, clinic doctors and general members of the Doctors Association.

## 6. Guidance for the cases of active reaction of tuberculin.

This guidance will be carried out throughout the year



for 2,500 cases ranging from 18 to 25 years old who showed the active reaction of the tuberculin.

7. Special health center for tuberculosis prevention.

Continuously from the preceding fiscal year, Utsunomiya Health Center will be designated as the special health center for the purpose, and the travelling diagnosis and preventive guidance will be carried out in parallel all through the year:

8. BCG Shot.

The periodical shot by virtue of the Preventive Immunization Law will be put to practice in spring for 200,000 personnel including major part of school children and for 200,000 in autumn when priority will be put on plants and other workshops workers as well as the general masses. In addition to the above, extraordinary immunization will be carried out for families of TB patients and general masses aggregating about 100,000. Additional remark is that we carried out the immunization for 5,345 persons up to the end of March from 1st January 1950.

9. Designation of special city for TB prevention.

We have designated Utsunomiya as the special city for TB prevention, where the death rate from TB showed 23 against 10,000 population. According to the project, we are trying to reduce the death rate in practically shortest period by means of variety of prevention methods.

10. Diagnosis of returned people from other prefectures.

To check spread of TB patients in agrarian villages in this prefecture, we are going to encourage the city, town and village offices as well as the health centers to find out TB infectious people. And then we plan to extend our adequate guidance by means of diagnosis and other treatment methods.



Trachoma Prevention Program.

1. Diagnosis by calling on the patients.

Four towns and or villages will be picked up as designated special areas. Three times of checks will be made for each area in respect of diagnosis and treatment with the object of obtaining the definite materials for prevention and treatment.

2. Sanitary education.

At a time the "Eyes Protection Day" is carried out on 10 October 1950, various types of printing matters will be prepared or purchased and distributed to the general masses to enlighten the idea of prevention.
