The Regulation for Metallic Arc Welding Rod Examination

Article 1. Any person who requests an examination concerning metallic arc welding rod to the Machine Examination Institute shall apply with a letter of application as in the annexed form together with an article to be examined and an examination fee.

Article 2. Any person who requests an examination under the preceding Article shall tender the following amount of metallic arc welding rod for each examination:

Article 3. The chief of the Machinery Examination Institute may order tender of a considerable additional rod if he deems it necessary.

Article 4. An article tendered for examination shall not be sent back.

Article 5. The chief of the Machinery Examination Institute may order an applicant to tender a tool, machine, material or labour if he demes it necessary for the prosecution of examination.

Article 6. The Japanese Standard for arc welding rod
(called "standard" hereinafter) shall apply to the
standard to approve of examination of manufacture of a test piece and of other method of testing

Article 7. Welding procedure, machining of test pieces and all the other matters pertaining to the examination shall be prosecuted by the chief of the Machinery Examination Institute; provided that arrangement of test pieces and welding procedure may be performed by an applicant if circumstance permits. In the abovementiened case, welding procedure shall be carried out with the presence

Article 8. The result of a test performed for examination shall be served to an applicant for examination and a approval certificate shall be given to him if an article tendered passed the examination. The duration of effectiveness of the examination shall be one year as from the day of examination.

Article 9. An approval of the examination may be cancelled if there be an illicit conduct concerning examination records or approval certificates.

Article 10. For an article that passed the examination, full name of maker of welding rod, brand, class of examination passed, duration of effective term and name of applicant shall be published in the Official Gazette.

Article 11. An official concerned shall put a cancellation stamp with black ink on an application paper and over coloured print on a revenue stamp after confirming the amount of revenue stamp that should correspond to the prescribed amount of fee; provided that this shall not apply to a case

where a payer put a cancellation stamp on it for the sake of his own convenience.

Article 12. Any person who wishes to pay a fee in cash shall pay the amount of the fee in the nearest head office, branch or agent of the Bank of Japan with a payment order similar to Form No. 8

under the Enforcement Detailed Regulation for National Tax Collection Law.

The present Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
