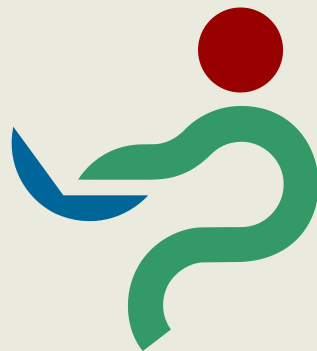

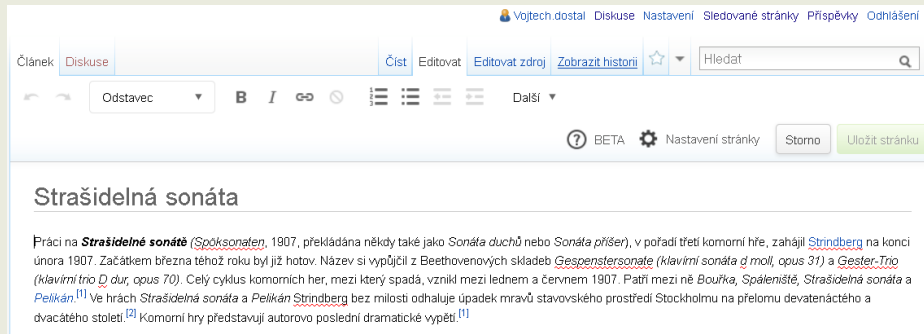

# LEADERSHIP SKILLS (I./III)

- BE A VISIONARY
  - What do you want to achieve in 6 months, 1 year, 3 years?
- BE MODEST IN THE BEGINNINGS
  - Start on a small scale.

# LEADERSHIP SKILLS (II./III)

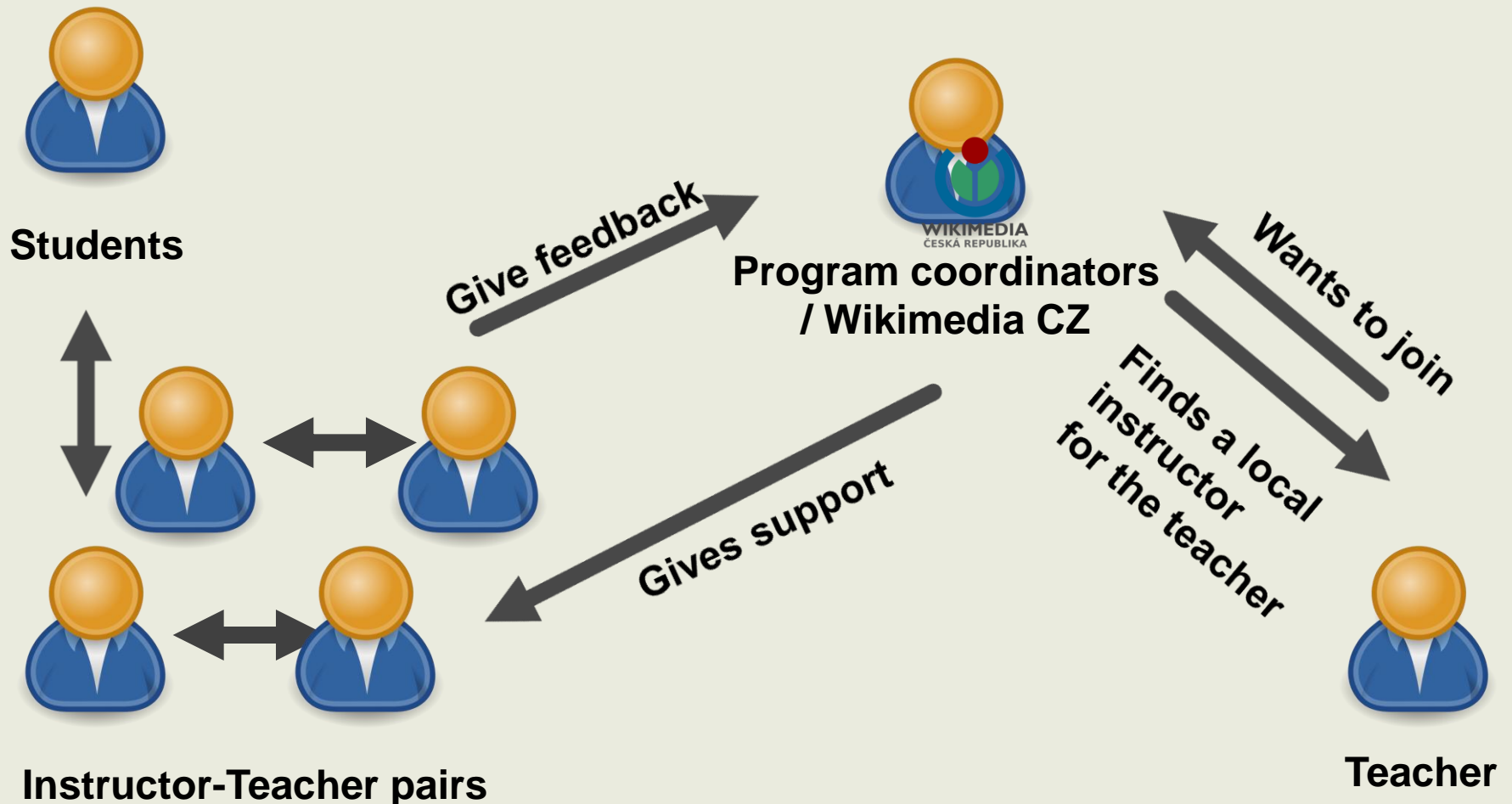
- CREATE A PLATFORM, NOT A COMPANY
  - Never take all the responsibility.
- HUNT FOR COLLEAGUES
  - Delegate and outsource!

# LEADERSHIP SKILLS (III./III)

- LIMIT BUREAUCRACY
  - Fancy statistics and monthly reports will take your energy away from more important things
  - Do not ask this from your teachers either – no long questionnaires or „formal“ agreements
- CHOOSE CAREFULLY WHAT YOU DO
  - Do only stuff you like – Wikimedia work is FUN!
  - Do only stuff that noone else could do, or noone else would do as well as you would.

# 1st PROJECT

- CHOOSE RELIABLE TEACHERS
  - Preferentially those that you know well
- THINK ABOUT THE ORGANIZATION
  - Make it as easy for teachers and students as possible
    - Suggest articles for creation
    - Help and review student articles („related changes“)
  - Motivate students to do their job well

    - Overall structure, headings, internal and external links, images, citing sources.
