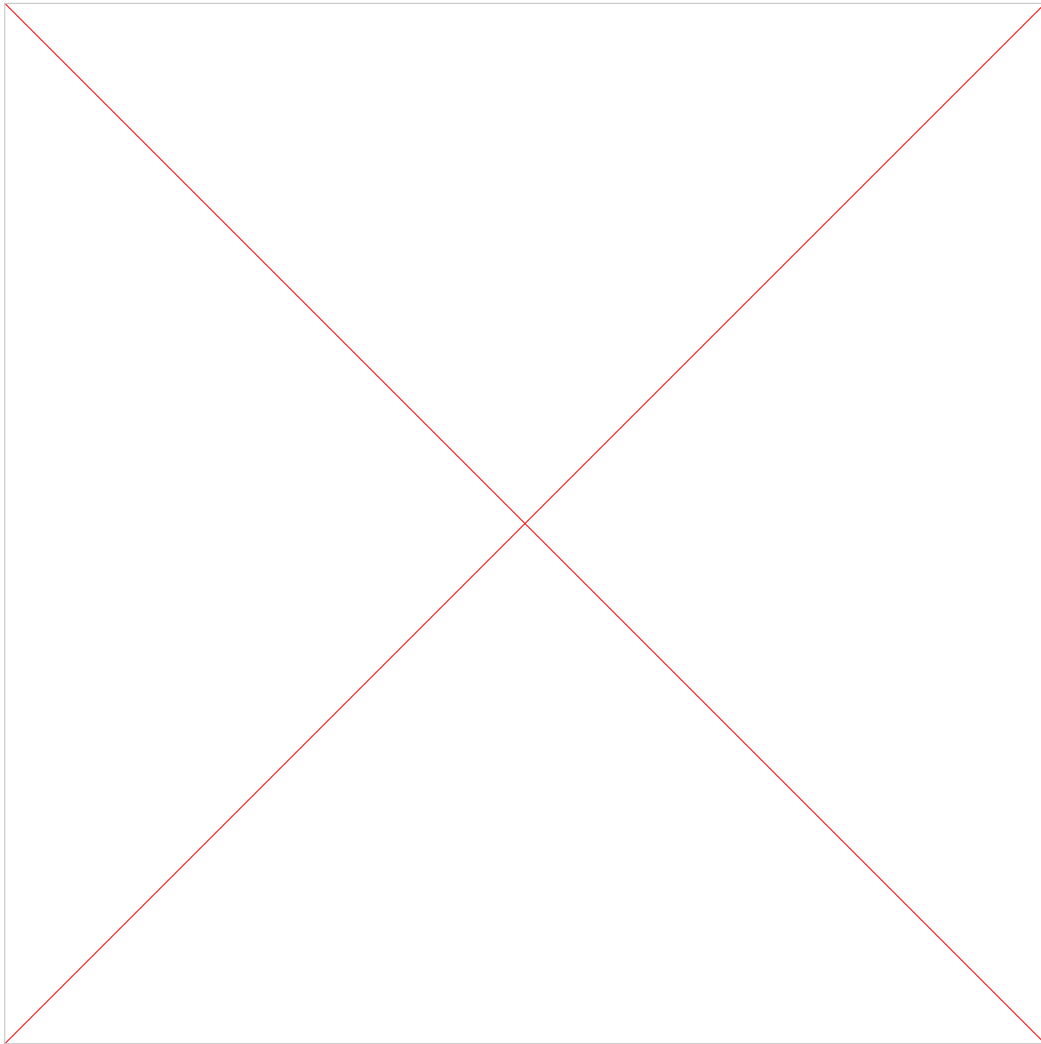

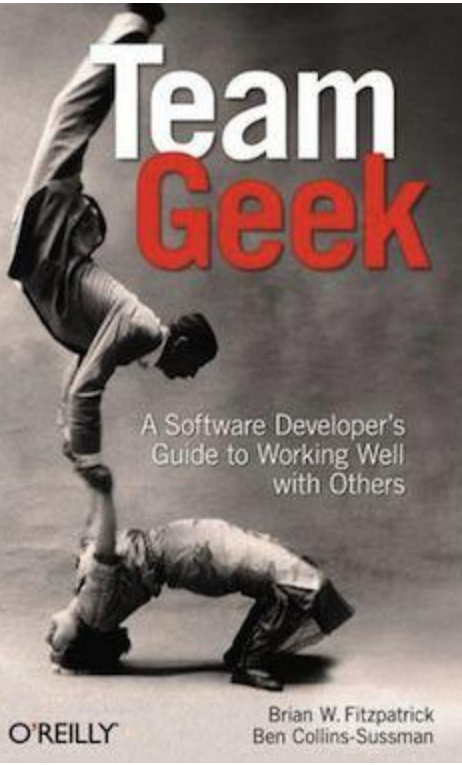

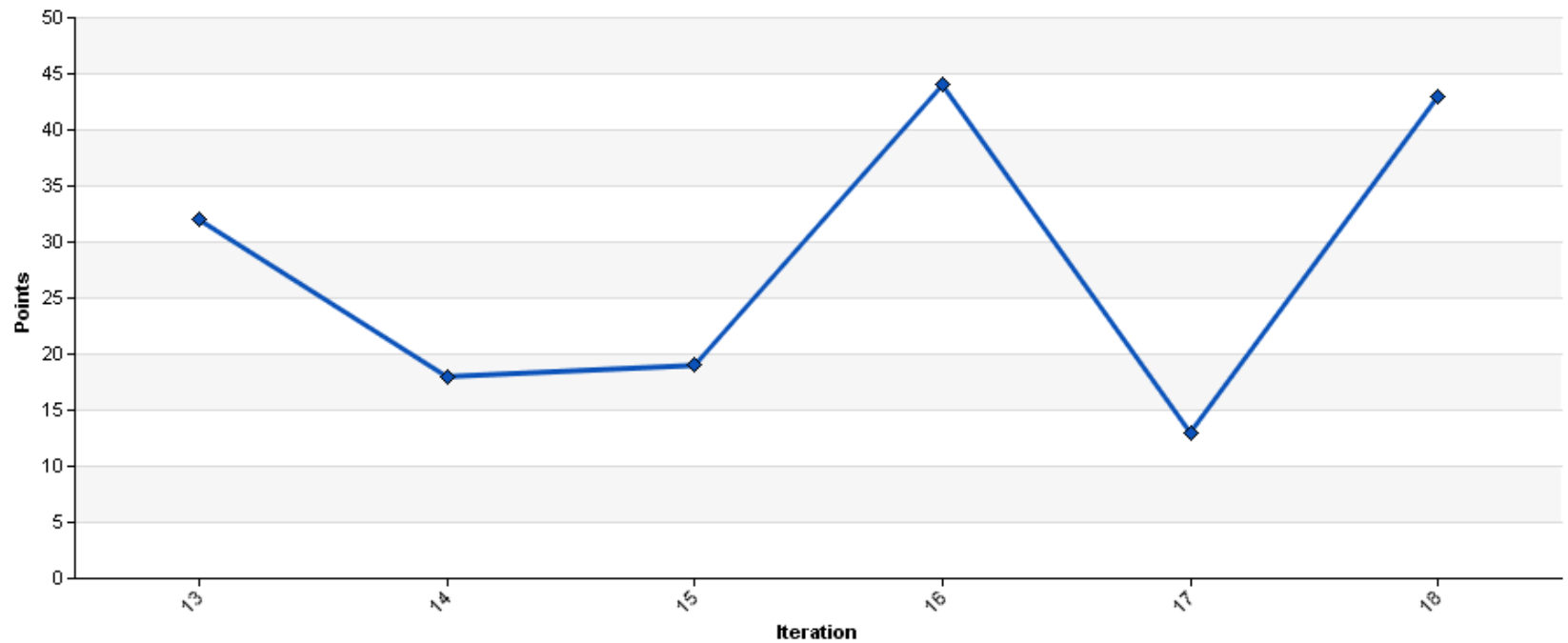

Velocity – What has been our pace of work this release?

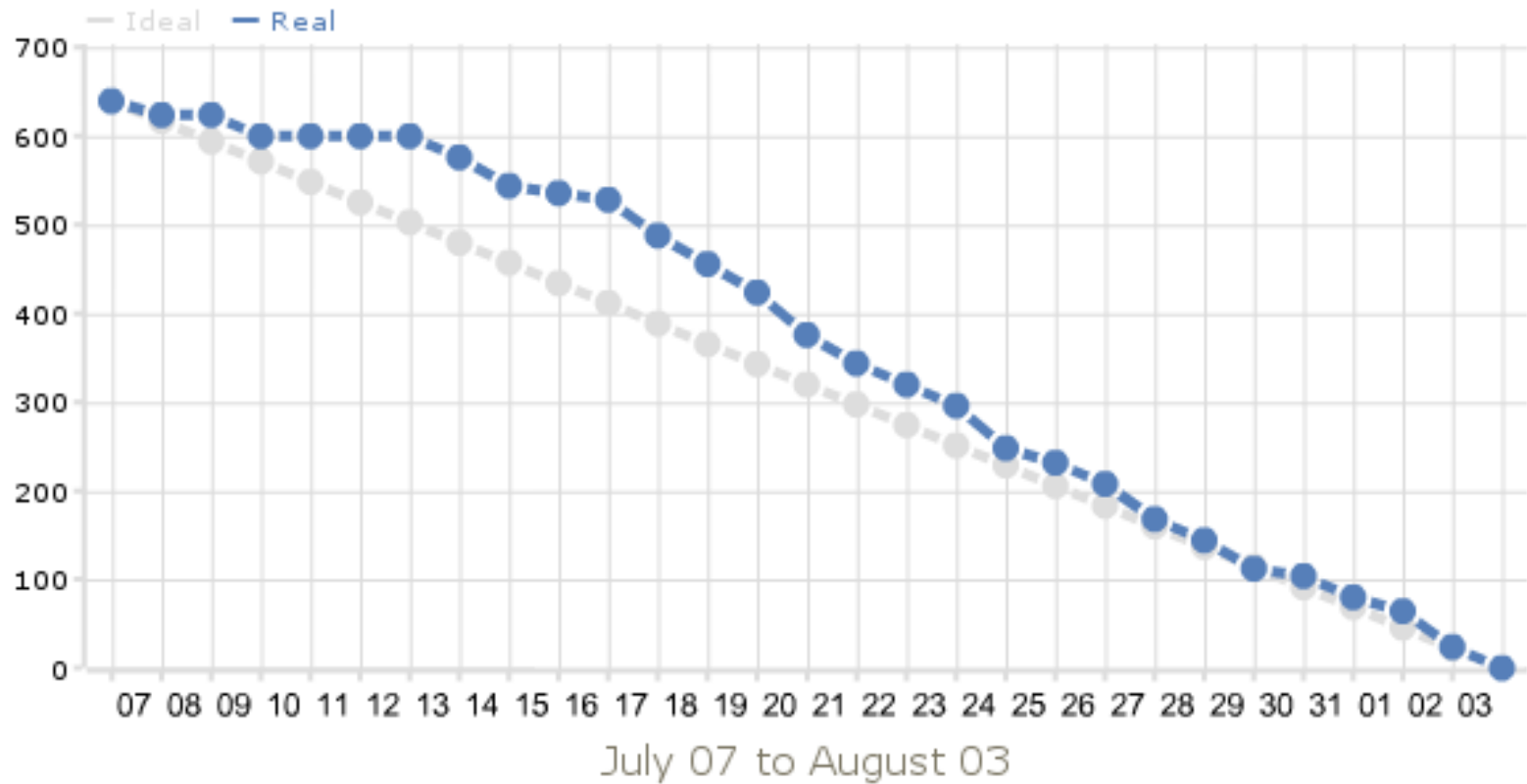


How does this velocity chart work?

Velocity

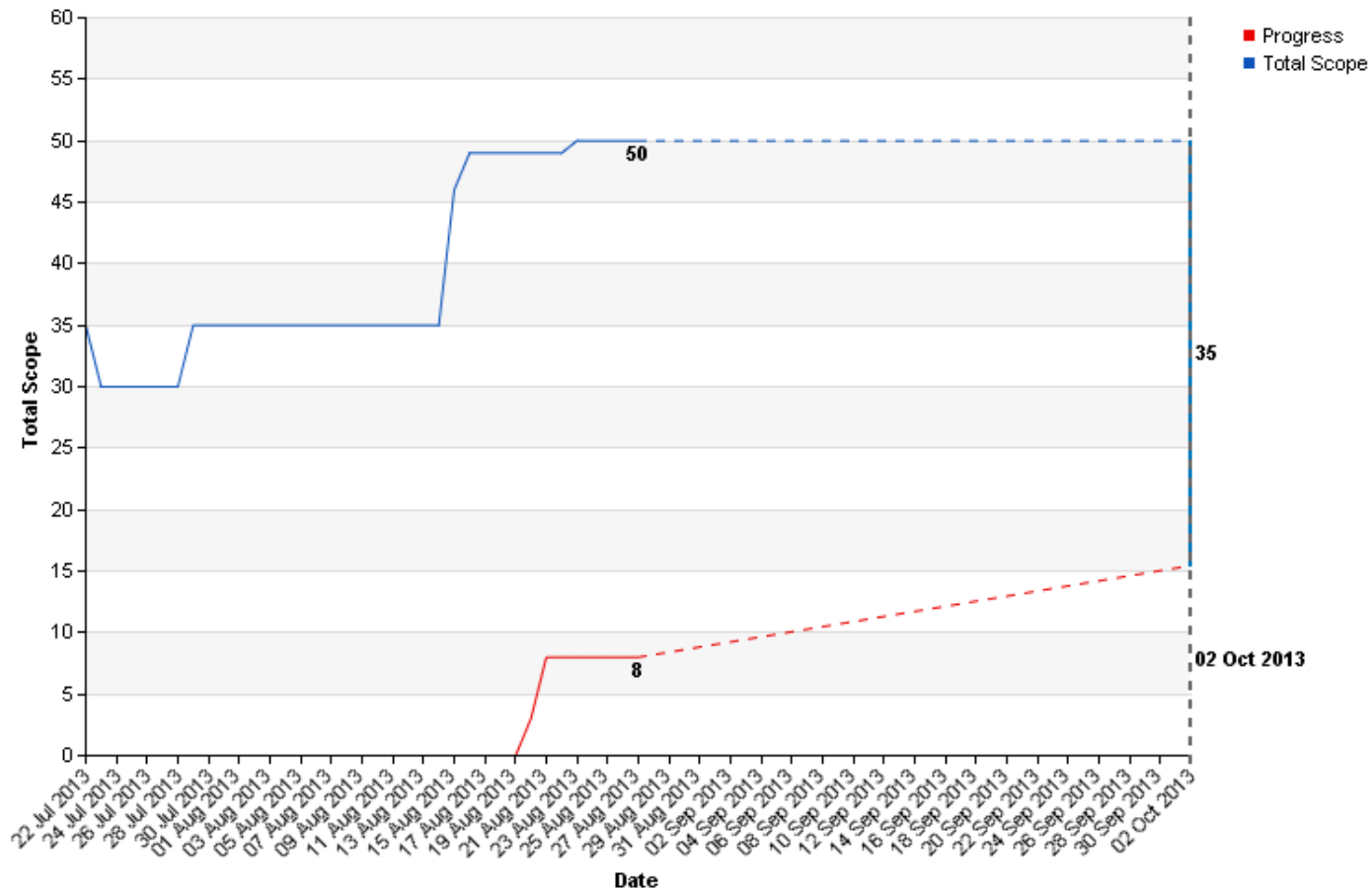
- Avg story points completed

As a mobile team, I want to see whether taking users straight to the editor and/or showing them a tutorial increases their likelihood of saving an edit

Acceptance Criteria

A/B test:

- * In beta, half of users who sign up for an account from a section other than the lead are taken straight to the editing interface of that section
- * In beta, half of users who sign up for an account from a section other than the lead are taken to the blue tutorial screen, and from there they can proceed to the editor

As a user, I want to thank users for good edits on mobile, so I can encourage them to keep editing.

As a mobile team, I want to get a sense of how many mobile thanks actions we can get, so I can know how many users will actually use mobile watchlist features.

Acceptance Criteria

On English Wikipedia:

- On the Special:MobileDiff page add a thanks button next to the username
- Tapping it will change the label to 'Thanked' and a toast message will read "Username was told that you liked her edit"
- Taps on thanks should be logged by EventLogging
