Intervals are based on normal hours of operation. Adjust to compensate for abnormal operation and severe conditions. During inactive periods sufficient lubrication must be performed for adequate preservation.

Level of maintenance is indicated at Note reference by (c) for Crew/Operator, and (o) for Organizational maintenance. Clean fittings before lubricating. Clean parts with SOLVENT, dry-cleaning, or OIL, fuel diesel. Dry before lubricating.

Drain crankcase when hot. Fill and check level.

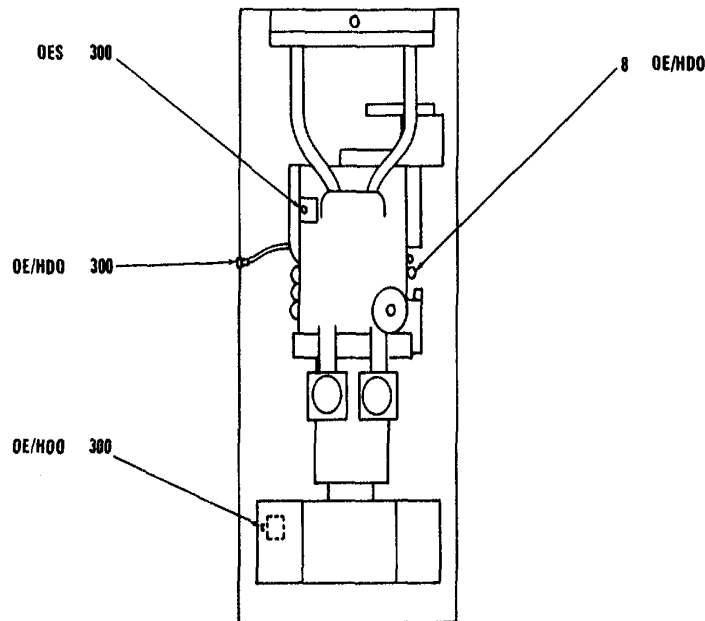
