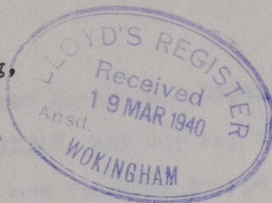

The above prize Ship, which is to be registered in the name of the Ministry of Shipping, has been committed to our management.

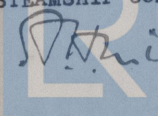
The Ministry have desired us to apply for classification with your Society and to obtain an International Load Line Certificate for the Vessel.
