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PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE ORDINANCE

Prime Minister's Office Ordinance No. 15

March 3, 1948

Regulations for the Enforcement of the Law concerning the Election of Members of the House of Representatives shall be partially amended as follows:

Prime Minister
KATAYAMA Tetsu

In the attached form of ballot paper,

“ Seal of metropolis, district or urban or rural prefecture ” shall read

“ Seal of metropolis (district or urban or rural prefecture) , in the (city) (town) (village) ”

remarks “The paper” shall read “1. The paper” and the following item shall be added to the remarks:

2. The seal of a city, town or village may be substituted for that of metropolis (district or urban or rural prefecture) to be impressed upon the ballot paper in accordance with the determination of the Electoral Administration Committee for metropolitan assembly-men or urban or rural prefectural assembly-men.

In the attached form of the envelope in accordance with the provisions of Article 31, Pars. 3 and 4 of the Law concerning the Election of Members of the House of Representatives and the attached form of the envelope for ballot in accordance with the provisions of Article 29, Par. 1 of the Ordinance concerning the Enforcement of the Law aforesaid,

“ Seal of metropolis, district or urban or rural prefecture ” shall read

“ Seal of metropolis (district or urban or rural prefecture) , in the (city) (town) (village) ”

remarks, “The seal of polling station” shall read “1. The seal of polling station,” and the following item shall be added to the remarks:

2. The seal of metropolis (district or urban or rural prefecture) to be impressed upon the envelope shall be conformed to the remarks 2 in the attached form of ballot paper.

In the form of the certificate of election, “(Torinoko Quarter)” shall be repealed.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Prime Minister's Office Ordinance shall come into force as from the next election.

In the case of the elections to be held during the year of 1948, the ballot paper map only be folded, and the method of insertion need not necessarily be taken notwithstanding the form of the ballot paper attached to the Regulations for the Enforcement of the Law concerning the Election of Members of the House of Representatives.

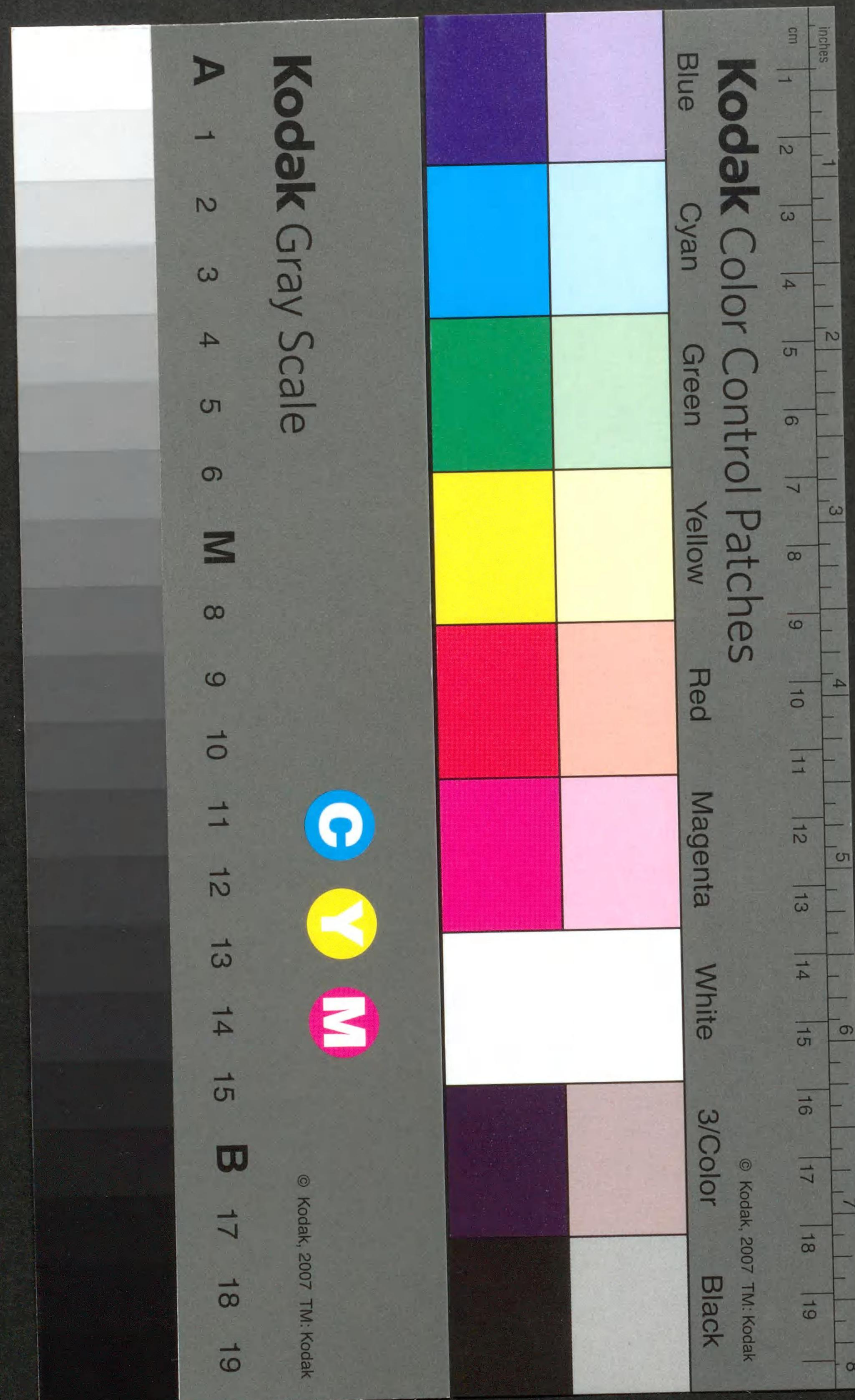
The numbers of students to be admitted to the government colleges in April 1948, and the main-point for their selection will be determined by each school.

Remarks: 1. No invitation of applicants for Tokyo College of Fine Arts shall be made for this once. Further the invitation of applicants for the 2nd Department of Kobe Technical College shall be suspended.

2. Date for selecting admittees

- (1) The date for selection of admittees shall be divided into the following two periods and the date of selection for each school is shown in the table of students to be admitted in the preceding notification.

Date of selection	Date of announcement of admittees
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- (a) First period from March 20 to 30, 1948
 (b) Second period from March 31 to April 10, 1948

- (2) The period for making applications shall be from February 15 to 29, 1948, for both the first and second periods.

3. Methods of selecting admittees

- (1) The selection of admittees shall be made synthetically by judging the results of written and physical examinations and the contents of principal's reports. However, in the Academy of Music, the investigations and examinations on the practical technique will be carried out in addition to the examinations mentioned above.

- (2) As to the written examination, the aptitude test and the scholastic-achievement test of the applicants shall be carried out. The aptitude test shall be conducted in order to test the ability sufficient to take the college education. This test shall be carried out for the applicants to government higher schools and colleges throughout the country at the same time on February 10, 1948, in each prefecture by the method separately stipulated. The scholastic-achievement test shall be carried out in each school and the questions will be given in the scope of attainments of the graduates of secondary schools (of those who completed the second year of new high schools).

- (3) The physical examination shall be carried out paying special attention to tubercular or infectious diseases, and even though applicants have partial physical defects, they will not be rejected on that account, if they are regarded to be able to prosecute their studies.

- (4) The oral examination (excluding the examination of foreign languages in the scholastic-achievement test) shall not be given. However, some schools will interview the applicants, but it will not be made as the judging material for selection.

- (5) In some schools, the selection of admittees may be made by dividing it into first and second selections, but for the information regarding this, the applicant should get in direct touch with the school to which he or she is applying for.

- (6) The selection of admittees by means of certification without examination shall not be put in practice the year, irrespective of the existence of school regulations to this effect.

- (7) The selection of admittees to the special courses, etc., shall be made in conformity with the general principles laid down for the regular courses.

4. Qualifications for Entrance

Those who fall under one of the following items have qualifications for entrance:

- (a) Graduates of middle schools or girl's high schools.
 (b) Those who have finished eleven school years since entering the elementary school or those who have finished curricula of equal number of class hours and who have been recognized to have scholastic attainments equal to those of the graduates of middle schools or girl's high schools.

For example:

- (1) Graduates of vocational schools (excluding such schools as are listed according to paragraph 19 of the Ordinance of Secondary Schools.

- (2) Graduates of the regular course of youth schools (excluding the youth schools of less than three school years)

- (3) Those who completed the preparatory course of normal schools (limited to those who completed it in or after March, 1948).

- (4) Those who have passed the certification examination in accordance with the Regulations concerning qualification examination for entering "Semmon Gakko" (College).

- (5) Those who have been designated concerning entrance to "Semmon Gakko," as having scholastic attainments equal to those of graduates of middle schools or girl's high schools.

- (6) Those who have finished 4th year of middle schools of the 5 year system or girl's high schools before March 31, 1944, and those who have been recognized as having equal or higher scholastic attainments by the Minister of Education.

5. Place of selecting admittees

As a general rule, the selection shall be made in the school to which the applicant is applying, but since some provisional examination places may be established in case of necessity, the applicant should get in touch with the school he is applying for to obtain information in this respect.

6. Procedure for application

- (1) The applicant shall write the necessary items in the application card (or the application paper) and send it together with the entrance examination fee (100 yen) to his almatem (secondary school). Whereupon, the almatem, after putting the principal's report concerning the applicant in order, shall send it to the school which the applicant wishes to enter, within the time-limit for application.

- (2) As for those applicants who are unable to get the principal's reports from their almatems on account of the abolition of then schools or the destruction due to war damages or some other circumstances, the graduation certificates and the records-report books or any other kind of papers which they can obtain may be used as substitutes for the principal's reports.

Furthermore in case the applicants are unable to prepare even the abovementioned documents owing to war damages, etc., they may tender such certificates concerning the above facts as have been written by the governors of applicants' native prefectures (or the government officials in charge of repatriation affairs) or by the principals of applicants' almatems (secondary schools). When they have received application papers of this kind, schools shall take a special test method.

- (3) As for such applicants who have passed the examination conducted according to the Regulations concerning qualifying examination for entering "Semmon Gakko" (College) or Regulations concerning qualifying examination for vocational school graduation level, etc., they may substitute the certificates obtained at one of these examinations for the principal's reports.

- (4) Applicants can apply to only one of the schools which make the selection at the same date.
