<p>Dispatch transmitted translation copy of revised draft of subject security Regulations dated 31 March 1954. <u>Ministerialrat DULLIEN</u> of the Fed Min of Interior informed representatives of the Allied Directors of Intelligence that the lack of further progress in providing for institution of the revised regs throughout all Federal and State offices in the FedRep was one result of the defection of Dr. JOHN and the resulting drop in the prestige of the Bundesamt fuer Verfassungsschutz, named in the revised regulations as the authority responsible for general supervision of implementation of the regulations and personnel screening. According to DULLIEN, shortly after JOHN's departure the IntMin received comments from some of the other Ministries seriously questioning those provisions of the revised regs with respect to the BfV's role in protective security. Although DULLIEN chose to attribute the delay in overall institution of the regs as an aftermath of the JOHN case, it must be borne in mind that JOHN did not leave until 20 July and, despite its March statements to the effect that negotiations with the several States were about to commence, that the FedIntMin apparently took no action on the revised regs between the end of March and that date. DULLIEN was unable to give an approximate date for the expected Cabinet approval of the revised regs. <u>DULLIEN is leaving the FedMin of the Int to take up a position with the Ethiopian Government.</u></p>

**Neuer Präsident des Bundeskriminalamtes**

Wiesbaden (UP)

Der neue Präsident des Bundeskriminalamtes, Reinhard Dullien, ist am Mittwoch in Wiesbaden durch Bundesinnenminister Schröder in sein Amt eingeführt worden. Dullien, der seit drei Monaten das Amt schon kommissarisch leitete, war vorher als Ministerialrat im Referat Verwaltungsorganisation des Bundesinnenministeriums tätig.

Bundesminister Schröder wies darauf hin, daß das Bundeskriminalamt heute noch in der Entwicklung stehe. Es werde bedeutender Anstrengungen bedürfen, das Amt zu einem immer wirksamen Instrument der Verbrechensbekämpfung zu machen. Die Kriminalpolizei müsse dem Rechtsbrecher, der sich heute auf Grund der technischen Entwicklung immer feinerer Methoden bediene, nicht nur gewachsen, sondern überlegen sein.

Dullien ist 1902 in Heidekrug (Ostpreußen) geboren, studierte in Berlin und Tübingen Jura und Volkswirtschaft, war seit 1938 Regierungsrat beim Oberpräsidium Königsberg und bis 1943 Direktor der öffentlich-rechtlichen Lebensversicherungsanstalt der ostpreussischen Landschaft und des ostpreussischen Sparkassen- und Giroverbandes. Seit 1940 war er im Bundesinnenministerium tätig.

At a special meeting called by CARAVEL to discuss another matter reported in EGFA-23067, CARAVEL remarked in passing that he had recently been queried by officials of the Ministry of Interior in Bonn concerning his opinion of the competence and character of</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">Reinhard *DULLIEN President of the <u>Bundeskriminalamt</u>.</p> <p>2. CARAVEL stated that he concluded from the nature of the questions asked him that DULLIEN's stock in the Ministry is sinking, and announced the possibility that within the next year or so DULLIEN will be replaced. In response to a rather direct question, CARAVEL added that the chances of DULLIEN's successor being a professional police officer are practically nil, and that very likely the position of President of the <u>Bundeskriminalamt</u> will always be filled by a man with a degree in law who has no practical experience of police work. In other words, CARAVEL's chances are dim.</p> <p>3. CARAVEL stated that he had given his assessment of DULLIEN forthrightly but without unnecessary editorializing, sticking entirely to facts. He considers DULLIEN incompetent in police work, weak as an administrator, lazy (he is particularly bitter that this entire summer DULLIEN has been on one kind or another of leave and CARAVEL has had to do all the administrative and executive work of the organization in addition to his regular heavy duties, with no prospect of leave for himself), and ineffective in his representational functions.</p> <p>4. Case Officer comment: So far as I know, CARAVEL is our only source on the character and competence of DULLIEN, and this latest report is consistent with earlier information. I recall/recent conversation with [redacted] however, in which the question of CARAVEL's possible potential for advancement in the government was discussed; [redacted] quoted [redacted] as saying (if I remember correctly) that CARAVEL himself was the object of some criticism in the Ministry, as being not sufficiently <u>salonfähig</u> to manage the representational functions of a top agency job and as being too direct of manner to deal adequately with the politicians and professional administrators. [redacted] with a law doctorate, also pointed out that CARAVEL is not a jurist. It may be, therefore, that CARAVEL's remarks to me about DULLIEN are motivated to some degree by a consciousness of his own inadequacies and that some of the ministerial questioning was directed against himself. We assume, therefore, that the "Ministerialrat" of reference is in error, and unless we hear from you to the contrary, we intend to correct reference to read "Ministerialrat DULLIEN".
