

Curiosities of California

Among the peculiarities of this peculiar country, its curiosities will perhaps compare could be written upon this single subject, but as we may at some future time advert to steamer yesterday, to this city. it, we will give but a single item-the head of the main fork of Feather River, which was visited in the summer of 1849, by Mr. A. Delano of this city,

Surrounded by high mountains, a broad valley is suddenly presented to the view of the traveller, covered with luxuriant grass, through which is seen branches issuing from the mountains that unite in sight, and together form a navigable stream, even to its very source

The principal stream gushes out from the base of a mountain, forming at once a stream eight rods wide and six feet deep, of crystal clearness; indeed, a pin could plainly be distinguished on the bottom. After uniting with other branches, several of which gush from the mountains in a similar manner, it flows many miles through the valley, bounded by picturesque hills, until it enters a deep cañon, in many places impassable, with numerous rapids and cataracts, until after a course of nearly three hundred miles, and after receiving its middle and south forks, it immerges from a rocky cañon three miles below Long Bar, at the base of table mounten to fifteen miles wide, and thirty or forty depend upon the prompter too often.

Thousands of water fowls cover its waters. numerous. Although gold has been found in small quantities in that region, the country does not appear to be so highly auriferous as at a distance of some thirty or forty miles below. Between this valley and the Sacramento, the road passes over a high and difficult mountain ridge, fifty miles in length, destitute of grass and water, and where there was much suffering among the emigrants in the fall of 1849.

THE TRAVEL TO SAN FRANCISCO .-- HOWland & Aspinwall's line of steamships between New York and San Francisco, and George Law's line, were to be consolidated on the 1st of April, inst., Messrs. Howland & Aspinwall taking the steamships on the Pacific side, and Mr. Law those plying between New York and Chagres. After the 1st, therefore, and until the opening of Captain Vanderbilt's new line, via Nicaragua, there would be no competition or opposition, in the carrying of passengers and light freight, between the Atlantic States and the new one on the Pacific

MEETING OF THE WHIGS .-- The Whigs hold a meeting this evening, at the Oriental House, corner of Bush and Battery streets, for the purpose of confirming the nominations already made for the charter election. A Gang of Horse Thleves.

On conditions that he be put on board an outward-bound vessel, Otis offered to lead the authorities to the haunts of the gang, and assist in their capture. The Indian was thereupon soundly horse-whipped, and turned loose, and the remainder given into the custody of the commanding officer of the garrison, who had, however, but five soldiers to guard them. Subsequently, fearing an attack, the officer gave them up to the Sheriff, and they were placed in the county jail.

On an examination of the person of Otis, there was found a bottle of nitric acid. a pair of green spectacles, and a roll of papers, embracing a complete map of the southern counties, the rivers, roads, passes, and ranchos. On another paper was a long list of names of individuals in various parts of the State, and among the number was Judge MARVIN, the State Superintendent of Common Schools. THE ISTHMUS .-- A new steamer has been placed on the Chagres river, to run between Chagres and Gorgona. Another steamer is building at Navy Bay, intended to be placed on the river as part of a daily line. About three hundred and fifty persons, principally Frenchmen, are engaged in working the Buena Ventura mines, of which the average vield is from two to three ounces per day.

The Herald of the 13th gives the following as the summary of the more important doings in Congress:

Congress adjourned on the 4th of March, at twelve o'clock. The two last sessions have occupied more days than any others since the organization of the government, and fewer acts have been passed than in any previous year. A special session of the Senate, in compliance with the President's wish, is now convened.

"A list of the acts passed during the recent session will be found in our columns. The most important are the Cheap Postage act; that to ascertain and settle private claims in California; one for founding an asylum for infirm and disabled soldiers, together with the Appropriation bill, and one directing the proceeds of the Custom House in California, prior to the twelfth of November, 1849, to be paid into the federal treasury. The River and Harbor, and the French Spoliation bills did not pass. Appropriations for new lines of steam ships to the coast of Africa and to China, were not granted. The additional appropriation in aid of the Collins' Liverpool line was not granted. The mail service on the Pacific (Howland & Apinwall's line) was increase to a semimonthly service, with pro rata pay.

" An amendment to the Post Office appropria tion bill, appropriating \$66,000 for incidental and contingent expenses of the Post Office department in California, was also passed.

Late from Europe By the arrival at New York of the American Mail Steamship Pacific from Liverpool, after a run of 12 days across the Atlantic-the secong wonderful winter passage of the Collins steamers-we have received late news from Europe.

The news from the Continent is one week later and of considerable importance. For the following synopsis of the intelligence, we are indebted to the New York Herald:

The most important news is the resignation of the Russel Ministry. They were beaten by majority of 43 on Mr. Locke King's motion for the extension of the borough £10 franchise to counties. The Manistry were opposed to the

The Times of the 21st ult. announces that Lord John Russell and his colleagues have resigned, their resignation to take effect as so as a new Ministry can be formed. Sir James Graham, at the Premier's suggestion, had been sent for by the Queen. Much excitement prevailed in the political circles of London, in con-sequence of the dissolution of the Cabinet.

In the sitting of the House of Commons, the House divided upon Lord John Russell's motion to bring in a bill to prevent the assumption of certain ecclesiastical titles, in respect to places in the United Kingdom. The result was, for the motion 395, against it 63—majority for bringing in the bill 332. Its chief enactment is, that any person assuming the name, style, or title of archbishop, bishop or dean, of any city, town, place, territory or district, without a legal authorization, is liable to a fine of £100 for each offence. It further declared void any deed or writing made, signed or executed, after the passing of this act by or under the authority of such assumers. It also prohibits the transfer of property by will, for the maintainance of such dignities as come under the enact-ment. I scarcely think Lord John can be accused of being too mild, for this act, if passed is an insurmountable barrier, as it brings all Panama.

FRANCE.-There is little news from France. As '52 approaches the interest will increase as to what France will do. The Bonapartists are sanguine as to the re-election of Louis Napo leon; and if he does not compromise himself, it is very likely to take place. He will be washed high and dry by the angry waves of his opnonents. He still entertains within his broast hopes of the imperial orown, and I believe he will leave no stone unturned to obtain it. Since the refusal of the donation bill he has commenced reducing his establishment, and has already sold some of his studs. He will reduce the expenses of the Elysee by not giving

Austria and Prussia. - The proceedings of Austria and Prussia are now beginning to excite serious alarms among the cabinets of Europe. The extension of the military power of these States, and the incorporation of the non-Germanic provinces of the Austrian empire—namely, Hungary and Lombardy—with the Central Bund, it regarded as a direct vio-lation of the treaty of 1815.

France and Great Britian have both protested by their respective governments against it. Of course all the minor States of Germany will be swamped. Hesse Cassel has no hope, and Hamburg is filled with Austrian soldiers. It is stated from Dresden that the Committees are in the act of terminating their debates, and that

the plenary meetings are about to commence. The central executive power is on the point of being established, and Prince Schwarzenberg and Baron Manteuffel are preparing for another interview at Dresden. Austria and Prussia intend to monopolize the military system, and o occupy the most important positions in Germany. An army of the two powers will occupy the country from Rastadt to Dusseldorf, with its headquarters at Mayence and Frankfort.

MILEAGE OF CALIFORNIA MEMBERS .- We find the following in the Washington Cor-respondence of the New York Herald, rela-

tive to this subject : The House, it appears, have construed that act to be limited to the long session, and have allowed Messrs. Wright and Gilbert their mileage according to the old law. that is, according the usually travelled route. Now, we all know that the usually travelled route from Washington to California is by way of New York and the Isthmus of Panama—the mileage, therefore the Isthmus of Panama—the mileage, therefore of Messrs. Wright and Gilbert has been decided by the Committee on Mileage accordingly, which, for seven thousand miles each way, will give those members an aggregate of \$5,600

This is all well enough. nileage. But we have another case. Congress have just passed a bill originating in the Senate, and which is now a law, prohibiting the allowance of constructive mileage. But, unfortunately, this act does not take effect till 1853, and in reference to the extra executive session upon the President's inaguration. At this special session of the Senate therefore, Senators, if they choose, may demand and receive their constructive mileafie. For example, Dr. Gwin, for the regular session just closed, is entitled to his mileage from California and back again; and whether he has been here and intends to remain here all the time or not, is nobody's business in particular. But five minutes after the regular session closed on the 4th of March, an extra session of the Senate assembled; and according to usage, Dr. Gwin is entitled to his mileage, as if in the interval of five minutes he had been to California and back. The following, then, is the result:

DR. GWIN'S MILEAGE. For the Session ending March 4...... For the Session commencing March 4...

We say that according to usage, Dr. Gwin is entitled to this mileage, assuming that for the regular and special session each, he has been out to California and back; and if the Senate act as usual, they will take out some \$50,000 among them for this constructive mileage.
