

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPILING "MONTHLY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS REPORT" FROM PREFECTURAL MONTHLY REPORTS

1. The data for columns 1, 3, 5, 6, 8, and 9 is secured from the public assistance statistical reports submitted monthly by the prefectures in the form of four tables.

a. Column 1 is the figure in parentheses in Item 4 of Table I. When only one figure appears in this item, that figure is to be used.

b. The figure for Column 3 is the figure appearing in parentheses as Item 9 of Table I. If only one figure appears, it is to be used.

c. The figure for Column 5 is from Table III under the heading of "Unemployed."

d. The figure for Column 6 is the figure in parentheses appearing as the total of Table II. If only one figure appears, it is to be used.

e. The figure for Column 8 is the yen figure which appears immediately following Table II.

f. The figure for Column 9 is the figure in parentheses as Item 5 of Table II. If only one figure appears, it is to be used.

2. The figures for Columns 2, 4, and 7 are secured by computation, as follows:

a. The figure for Column 2 is secured by dividing the figure in Column 1 by the population of the prefecture. This will be expressed as a percentage figure.

b. The figure for Column 4 is secured by dividing the yen figure in Column 3 by the figure of Column 1.

c. The figure in Column 7 is secured by dividing the figure in Column 6 by the population of the prefecture.


