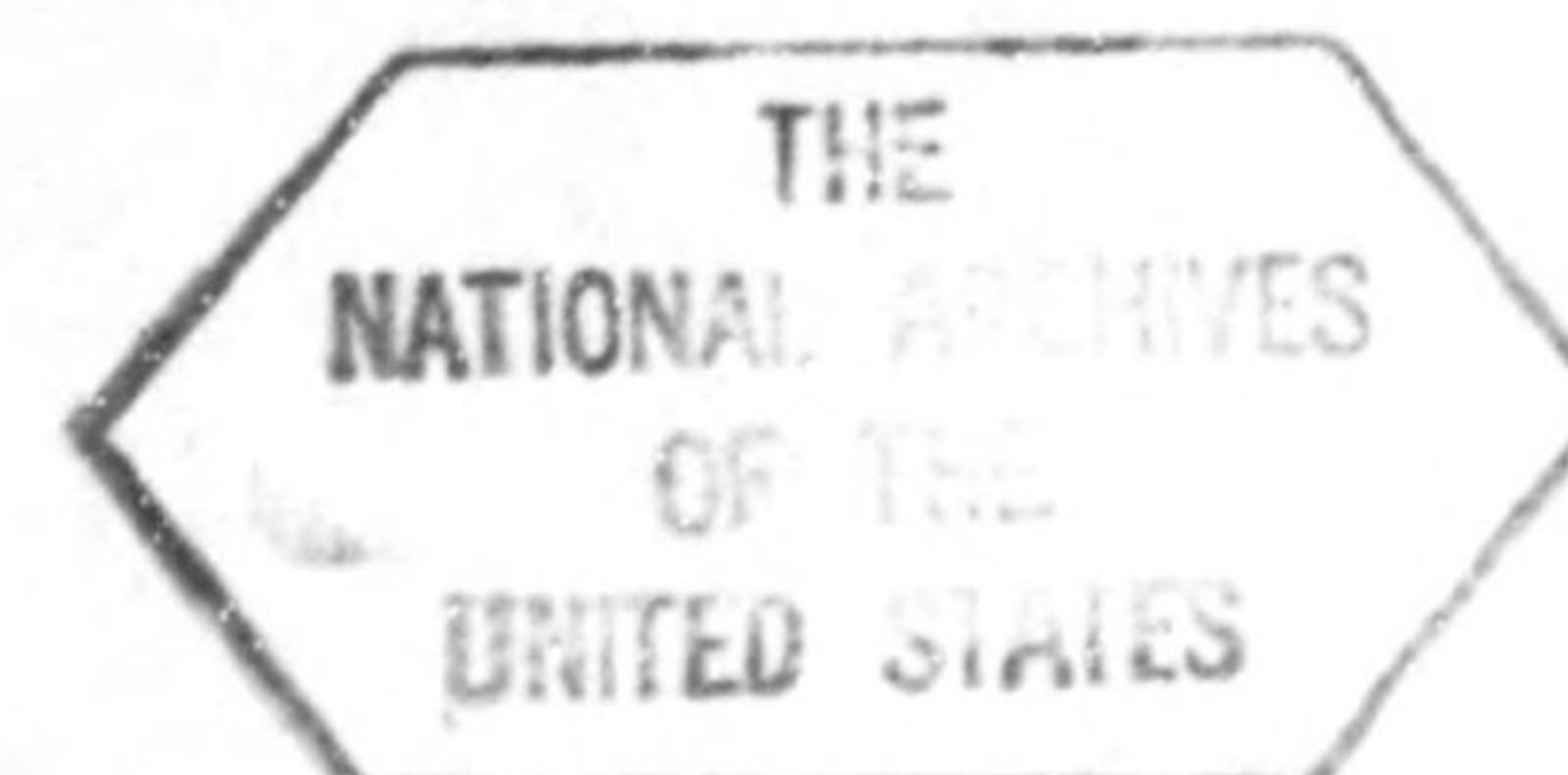

1. Reference is made to

(a) SCAP radio CX-57917 of 12 January 48 informing Department of State of SCAP interest in sending representatives to meetings on nutrition, fisheries and rice, accompanied by Japanese nationals as technical advisers. (TAB A).

(b) WSD radio 142310Z (13th) stating Fisheries and Nutrition Conferences now scheduled February 23 to 29 and Rice Conference Mar 1 to 14, in Baguio. (TAB B).

(c) CG USAFIK radio NGAGR 142 of 24 Jan 48 expressing desire for representation at Baguio and stating names of representatives. (TAB C).

2. In accordance with statement in reference (a) that upon notification that meetings are to be held, reference (b), qualified Japanese nationals will be selected at same time as SCAP representatives and names forwarded, enclosed telegram (TAB D) has been prepared for C/S approval giving the names of individuals selected for the Nutrition and Fisheries Conferences. The names of the individuals to represent SCAP at the Rice Conference which is being held at a later date will be sent to Washington as soon as the selection has been made.

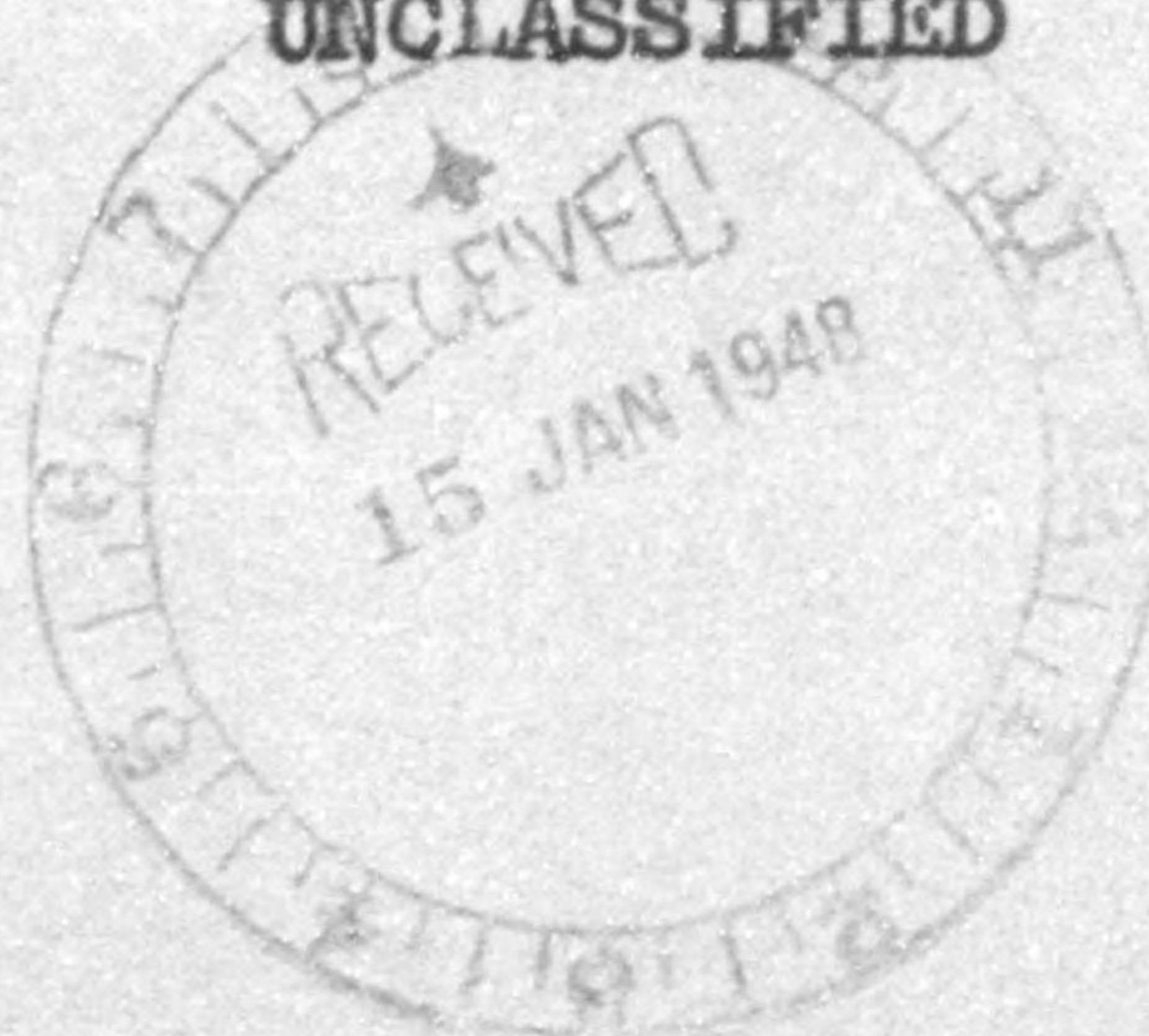
