Student Groups Pilot Program Plan and Timeline

Preparation Phase

December: Launch pilot, outreach to student groups to gauge interest.

January: Obtain commitments from selected student groups; prepare training and activities for each student group.

Early Milestone

Jan 30th – Commitment: selected student groups have officially committed!

Execution Phase

February: Travel to all campuses and conduct training, engage with each student group.

March: Oversee student projects; begin evaluating viability of the pilot. April: Travel to all campuses to engage students and continue evaluation.

Mid Milestones

Feb 30th – Goals & Excitement: all student groups know how to contribute to Wikipedia, are excited, and have clear goals.

March 15th – Internal milestone: all students have Wikipedia usernames and have contributed to their projects.

April 15th – Student leader: we have identified a student leader within each student group.

April 30th – Content: student groups have completed significant work toward their project goals.

Documentation Phase

May: Write and review final report.

June: End of project.

Final Milestone

June 15th – End of Project: final report written; documentation published around future of the pilot.
