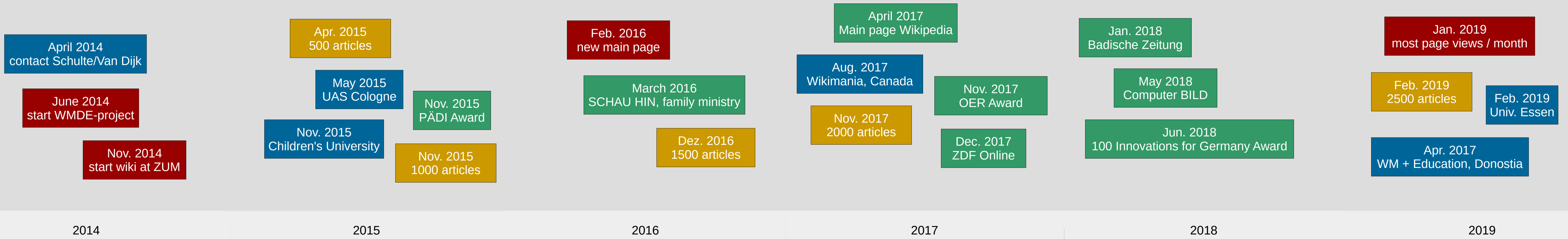


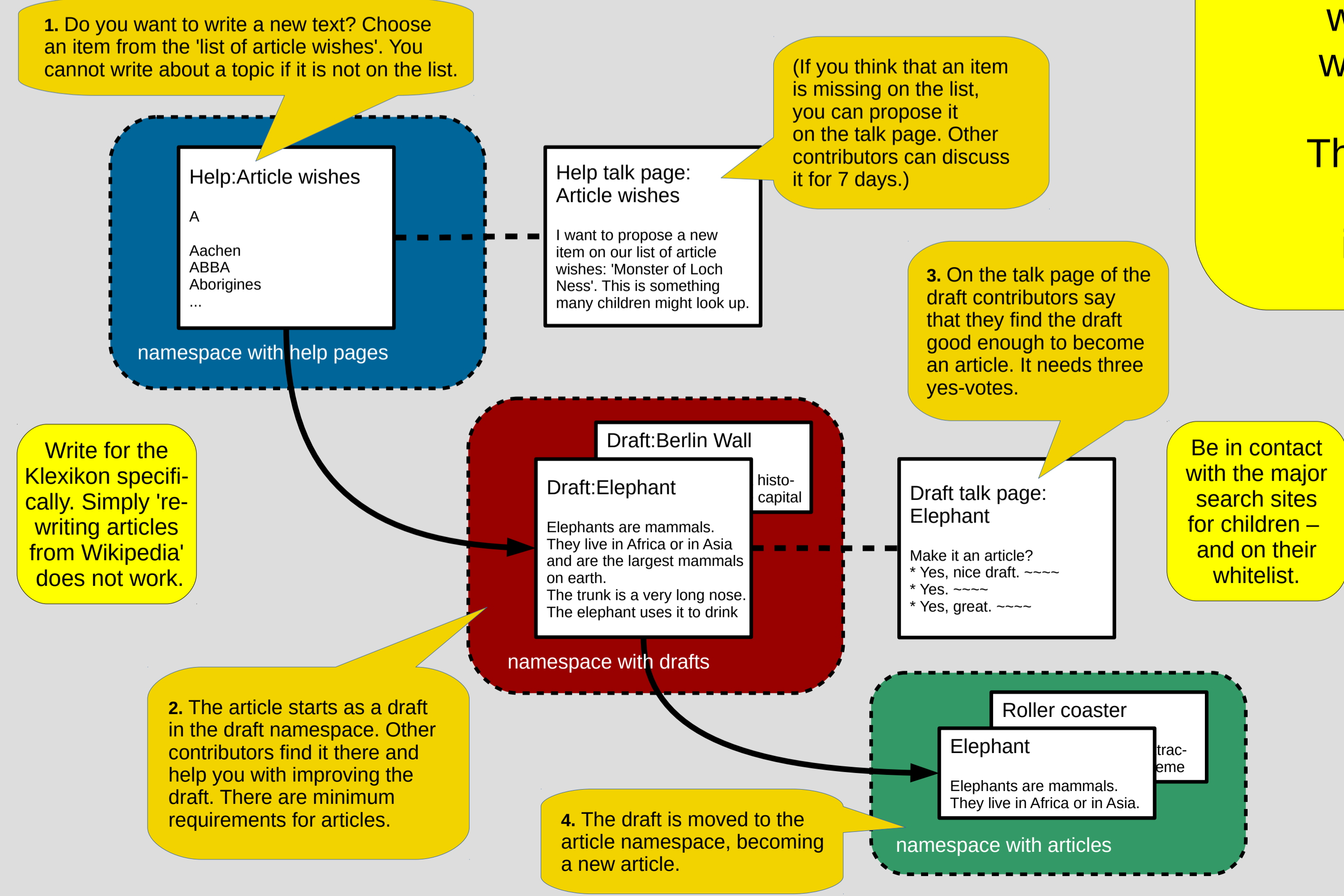
HISTORY OF THE KLEXIKON

- Wikimedia Deutschland (WMDE) is a non profit club that supports wikis and free knowledge.
- In 2010 started a project in German Wikipedia with children articles about medicine. The community voted against it.
- ZUM e.V. is a German association of OER activists and teachers. They host Klexikon.
- The word 'Klexikon' stems from the German words *Kinder*, children, and *Lexikon*, encyclopedia.
- Start early with the wiki, but have a good basic set of rules from the beginning.
- Our report for WMDE, about the creation of a wiki encyclopedia for children, was translated to English.
- In 2015, Klexikon received 640,000 page views, and 5,900,000 page views in 2018.
