Flood-affected people**

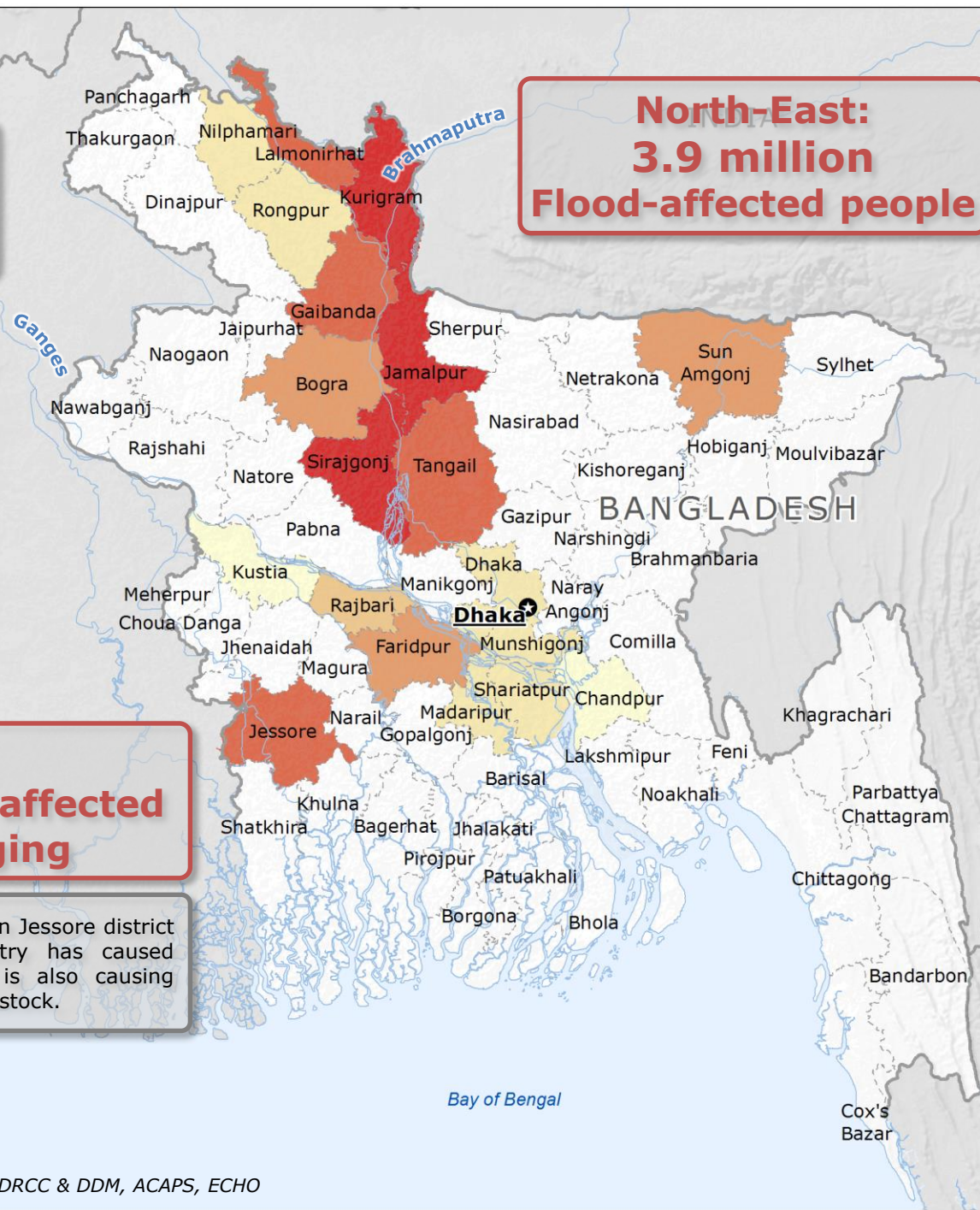
The current floods are the most severe that the country has faced since the 2007 mega floods, in terms of the number of people affected.

3.9 million

The northern part of Bangladesh has experienced very heavy rainfall since 20 July, exacerbated by the high flow of upstream rivers from India. The impact of the monsoon has been increasing gradually over the past weeks, and is likely to worsen, since the monsoon season continues until the end of September.

**Jessore:
300 000 people affected
by waterlogging**

Over the last days, heavy rainfall in Jessore district in the south-west of the country has caused waterlogging. This waterlogging is also causing damage to crops, fisheries and livestock.
