During the year 1937 the Seventh Biennial Conference of the World Federation of Education Associations was held in Tokyo, Japan, from August 2nd to August 7th.

The following are excerpts from addresses delivered by the outstanding educators of the world at that time, among whom were several noted Japanese educators.

In an opening address delivered by H. E. Ichita Kobashi, Mayor of Tokyo, the following remarks were made at the Conference (page 15):

"I dare say, however, that there is one common desire on the part of all nations and races, namely, the desire for harmonious relations and peace among them all.
