PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE ORDINANCE

Prime Minister's Office Ordinance No. 13

August 15, 1947

The following partial amendments shall be made to the Regulations regarding Extraordinary Census of 1947:

Prime Minister KATAYAMA Tetsu

Article 18. The mayor of a city or headman of a town or village shall frame statistical tables, according to the form fixed by the Prime Minister, on the basis of the schedules and accompanying papers, and forward them to the prefectural governor by the date fixed by the said prefectural governor.

The prefectural governor shall frame statistical tables, according to the form fixed by the Prime Minister, on the basis of the statistical tables submitted by the mayor of a city or headman of a town or village, and forward them with the statistical tables submitted by the mayor of a city or headman of a town or village to the Prime Minister by the date fixed by the Prime Minister.

In Art. 20. "in the corresponding administrative division thereof, and in areas where wards exist in Tokyo Metropolis" shall read "in the corresponding administrative division thereof, in the wards of Tokyo Metropolis, Kyoto City, Osaka City, Yokohama City, Kobe City and Nagoya City."

Supplementary Provision:

The present Prime Minister's Office Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.


