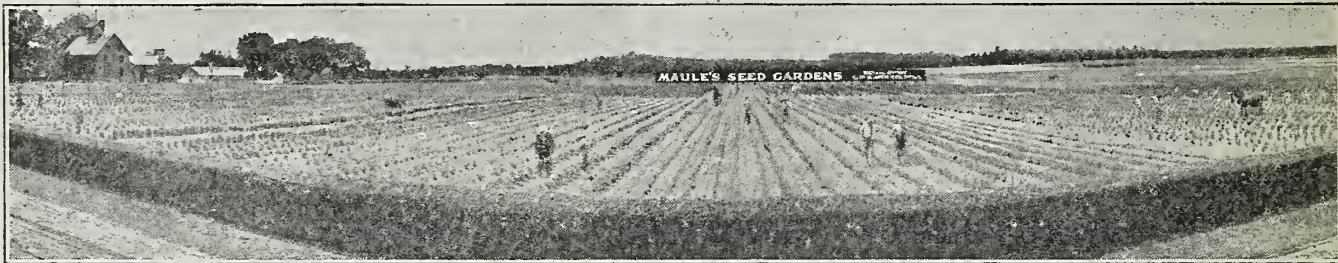

We Prepay Shipping Charges

We pay freight or express charges, our option, to your nearest railroad station on all order for small seeds amounting to \$10.00 or over. Transportation charges are not prepaid on orders containing heavy seeds, such as peas, beans, corn, potatoes, roots, vegetable plants, onion sets, nor on sprayers, spraying materials, tools, etc.

We Make No Charge

for bags, boxes, crates or packing, nor for delivery to freight, boat or express offices in Philadelphia.

We Will Ship Your Order Promptly

You will find it advantageous to order all the seed you will need at once, so as to have your full supply reserved. If you wish, we will ship the seeds for early planting at any date you name, and hold the balance of your order to be shipped later.

What You Should Do

Order Early

Be sure to get your order in early. While our supply of seeds should be adequate, yet the demand is certain to tax us heavily. The earlier you order, the more certain you are of having seeds exactly when they are needed for proper planting. Mail, express and freight are sometimes delayed, so order early.

Accurate Address

Write your full name and complete address on every order. Give your post office address and name of state and county. If you have a post office box or live on an R. F. D. route, please give the number. If the goods ordered are to go by freight or express, give shipping directions and the name of the railway station where goods are to be delivered.

The safest way to send money is by post office money order, express money order or bank draft. On all amounts of \$1.00 or over you may purchase your money order or register your letter at our expense. Stamps will be acceptable as cash.

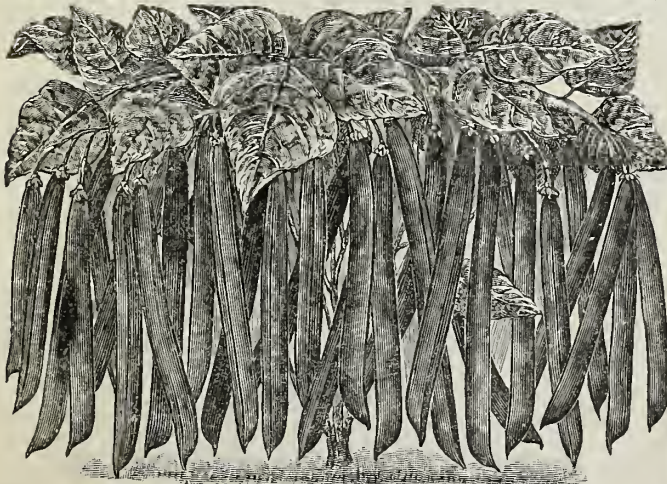
