The men stated on several occasions that they had only a very hazy conception of conditions in the coal, iron and steel industries. However, after a considerable amount of urging, they agreed: (1) To prepare data on coal production in Manchuria, by mining districts, from 1940 - 1944. (2) To submit data on coal exports from Manchuria to Japan and Korea.
