1. Reference is made to Section II, Annex III to Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 370.05 (7 May 46)GC, (SCAPIN-927), datod 7 May 1946, subject: "Repatriation," as amonded.

- 2. Due to a railroad strike in Korea, repatriation of Koreans including return of illegal immigrants to Korea is suspended this date until further notice.
 - The Imperial Japaneso Government will:
- a. Cease the embarkation of all repatriates, including illogal immigrants destined for Korea effective at once.
- b. Hold and care for all Korean repatriates now at reception centers or enroute thereto until such time as this suspension is lifted.
