MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT.

THROUGH : Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT : Repatriation to Korea.

1. Reference is made to Section II, Annex III to Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 370.05 (7 May 46)GC, (SCAPIN-927), dated 7 May 1946, subject: "Repatriation," as amended.

2. Due to a railroad strike in Korea, repatriation of Koreans including return of illegal immigrants to Korea is suspended this date until further notice.

3. The Imperial Japanese Government will:

a. Cease the embarkation of all repatriates, including illegal immigrants destined for Korea effective at once.

b. Hold and care for all Korean repatriates now at reception centers or enroute thereto until such time as this suspension is lifted.
