1. Request necessary copies of the attached directive be referred to all Army units assigned or attached to your headquarters and to all units of Far East Air Forces for compliance with the provisions thereof.
2. The inclosures to the attached directive consist of those items previously reported upon plus those recently added by directive from your headquarters. It is considered necessary that an up-to-date report be obtained on all items in order that field and depot inventories might be simultaneous.
3. In the case of Air Force units, Phase I reports on the original list of items have been received from three installations, Far East Air Materiel Command, Japan Air Materiel Area and Misawa Air Force Base. SUBJECT: Letter, Hq 8th Army, AGGS 400.4, SERV PROJECT, 9 Aug 49.

1. By basic ltr CG 8th Army transmits 500 copies of ltr 8th Army, AGGS 400.4, subj SERV PROJECT, 10 August 1949, which contains as inclosures lists of items of the Several tech svcs exclusive of Transportation Section on which SERV PROJECT progress reports as of 30 Sept 49 are required. 8th Army requests GHQ to make distribution to Army units of GHQ and units of FEAF for compliance with their letter.

2. Para 3 of basic ltr points out some difficulties being encountered by 8th Army in securing timely and proper reports, covering SERV PROJECT, from FEAF. By previous correspondence 8th Army requested and was granted authority to correspond directly with CG FEAF on subsequent SERV PROJECT reports. Because of this, contents of basic ltr are not being fwded to FEAF by GHQ but are being returned to 8th Army with instructions that they correspond directly with FEAF in the event such action is deemed necessary.

3. By 1st Ind, GHQ advises 8th Army to take the action as directed in para 2 above. 8th Army is also advised that GHQ has made proper distribution of the 500 copies of their directive as follows:

- b. 40 copies to CG Hq & Sv Gp.
- c. 10 copies retained by G-4 GHQ.

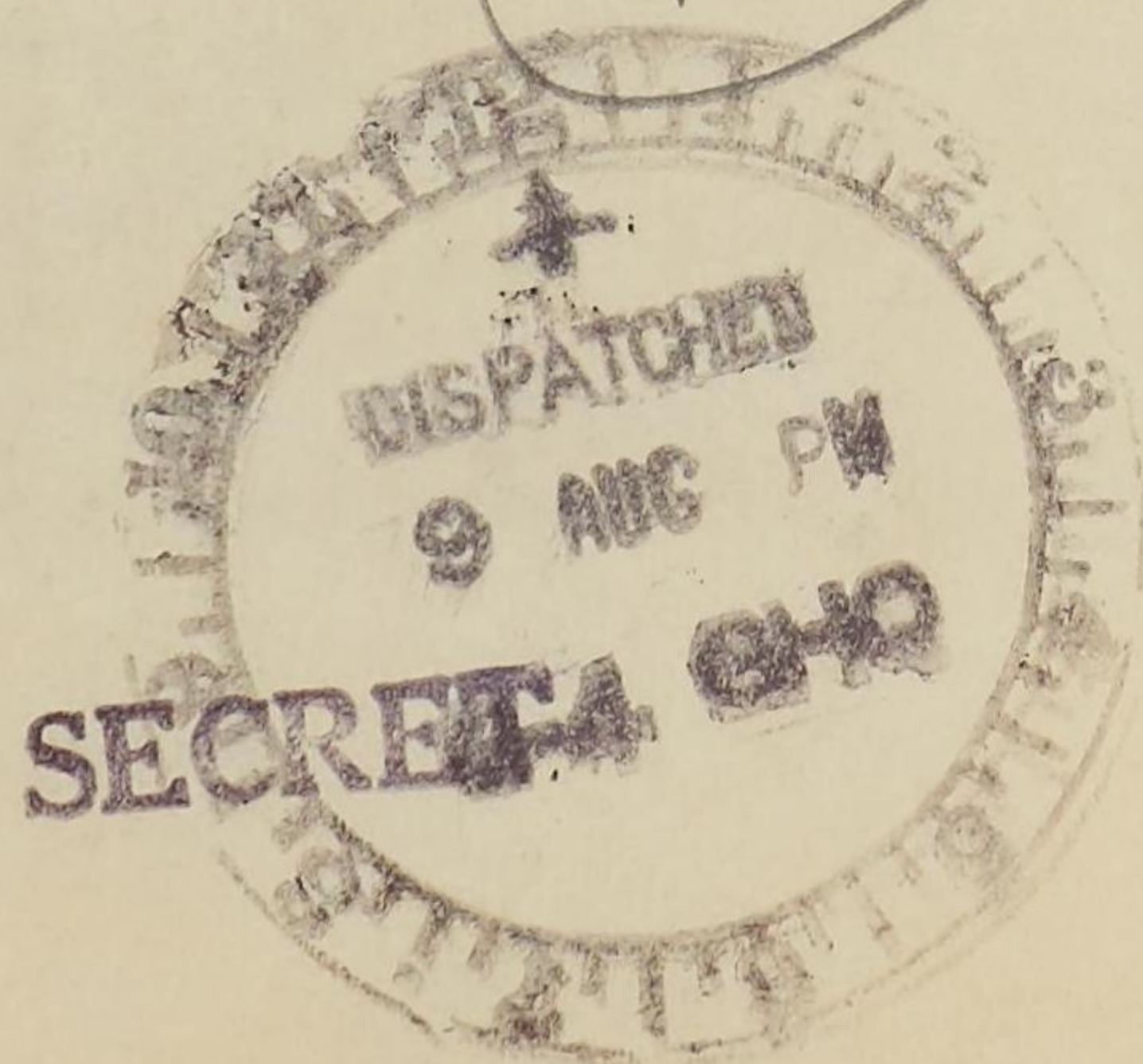

2. Reports rendered your headquarters in compliance with reference 1a have not been complete inasmuch as Air Force assets and requirements have not been included. Therefore, any action, such as that indicated in reference 1e, predicated on the contents of the reports as rendered may result in considerable confusion and embarrassment at a subsequent date.

3. Air Force units were included in the distribution of reference 1c, which requested an inventory of assets in the hands of troops and a computation of requirements. Subsequently your headquarters again requested of Far East Air Forces (reference 1d) that certain necessary information be furnished this headquarters. In response to the latter request, reports from two Air Force installations have been received to date.

4. In implementation of reference 1b, it will be necessary for this headquarters to require a Phase I report on additional items from all Army and Air Force organizations. Publication of this directive is being withheld pending receipt of a revised list of signal items to be reported upon.

5. It is extremely important that this headquarters be able to furnish your headquarters with accurate, up-to-date data as concerns availability of equipment excess to all requirements and a knowledge of Air Force assets and requirements is a basic consideration in the preparation of such data. It is therefore requested that Air Force organizations be advised of the necessity for the utmost cooperation in this matter. It is further requested that this headquarters be subsequently authorized to correspond directly with Far East Air Forces concerning details and manner in which necessary data are to be submitted.

1. Department of the Army policy in regard to program for civilian aid in the Pacific is stated in Department of the Army (DACA) message WX 90312, 17 June 1949, to Commander in Chief, Far East, information copy to Commanding General, Ryukyu Command. In order that demands on the United States' economy may be reduced to a minimum and in the interests of improving the economic and social well being of the Ryukyus people, necessary steps will be taken to insure that surplus supplies and materials procured from War Assets Administration are allocated and distributed effectively.

2. In the accomplishment of the above, it is directed that:

a. Excess supplies and equipment will be allocated in the overall interest. Such allocations should be made under the direct supervision of the Military Governor.

b. Inventories and descriptions of available materials for use in the civil economy of the Ryukyus will be circularized in advance to personnel responsible for execution of civil administration policies. Such personnel must be given the opportunity to inspect and requisition these supplies.

c. Programs and budgets will reflect the availability of surplus supplies and materials and justification therefor will specifically include mention that availability of these materials has been taken into full consideration.

3. Proper accounting and stock record procedures will be maintained carefully. To assist you toward that end, the Officer in Charge, Audit Agency, Far East Command, in residence at Okinawa, will be directed to

Memo for Record:

1. C/S on 19 Jun 49 discussed with Chief, HMG, proper utilization and accounting in Ryukyus MG of surplus materials received from WAA, Army and Navy sources, questioned by DA msg WX 90212. Latter msg indicated DA specific concern was that excess supplies and materials were not being fully considered in formulation of ERQA programs.

2. At direction of C/S an investigation as to the extent to which availability of excess supplies and materials was being coordinated with statements of ERQA reports by HICOM MG was completed by Chief, HMG.

3. It was concluded that proper controls to effect this coordination were not being exercised.

4. Inst ltr to Mil Governor directs proper allocation and distribution of such surplus supplies and materials and that:

a. Allocation to using agencies will be under direct supervision of the Mil Governor.

b. Availability of surpluses will be circularized to MG pers, who will be given full opportunity to inspect and requisition.
