



State by what particular line, route or express, and the name of the place, station or express office you want goods sent to, always giving the full post office address.

When six or more guns and other goods are to be sent at one time, the cost of freight is only about half what it would be by express, but takes double the time to reach their destination. Any small box or package of goods goes as cheaply by express as by common freight, and with much more safety.
