1. Reference is made to letter, Headquarters, 315th Composite Wing, file AG-684 E, Subject: "Request for Bombing Range", dated 5 July 1946. Hamanatsu Dive Bombing Range was approved for use by the Fifth Air Force in 5th Indorsement, Headquarters, Far East Command, dated 5 July.

2. The danger area, as approved, has a radius of one half mile. This danger area is not large enough to allow any type of air to ground work except horizontal bombing with 100 lb practice bombs. Japanese houses are located all around the range right up to the existing danger area. Extension of the present danger area would require that quite a large number of Japanese people be moved.

3. Since the utilization of this range is restricted to such an extent, it is considered impractical to retain the range any longer for use by units of this command.

4. The range will not be utilized by Fifth Air Force units subsequent to this date.
