Excerpt from the Judgment of the International Military Tribunal
in Session at Nurnberg, Germany - 1946

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In view of all of the facts proved and in particular of an order of the British Admiralty announced on the 8th of May 1940 that all vessels should be sunk at night in the Skagerrak, and the answers to interrogatories by Admiral Nimitz that unrestricted submarine warfare was carried on in the Pacific Ocean by the United States from the first day that nation entered the war, the sentence of Doenitz is not assessed on the ground of his breaches of the international law of submarine warfare.
