MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY,
STATE-WAR-NAVY COORDINATING COMMITTEE:

The Subcommittee for Technical Information Security Control voted unanimously at the meeting held March 7, 1946, to request SWNCC to authorize the Subcommittee to change its name to the Subcommittee for Military Information Control (abbreviation: MIC).

The Subcommittee felt that its name should be changed because of the re-definition of the terms "military information" and "technical information" in SWNCC 206/9. Under present circumstances, the term "military information" is more accurate as a description of the type of information over which the Subcommittee exercises control, in accordance with the provisions of SWNCC 206/9.

The Subcommittee, therefore, requests that its name be changed to "Subcommittee for Military Information Control."
