

#### NARRATIUE:

Major Meyer took off at 1600 (K Zone), April 8 1945, leading a five (5) plane division, four (4) carrying one (1) x one thousand 1b. G.P. bomb each and the other was loaded with one (1) 150 gallon belly tank of napalm.

Two (2) bridges near Ngatpang constituted the targets for this flight. One (1) of these has been destroyed and rebuilt several times during the past three (3) months.

Runs were made individually, one section on each bridge, initiating and gliding in at a 25° angle to the release point at 50 feet above the targets. (See diagram).

The Northern bridge received a direct hit which blew up the entire structure and most of the approaches which had been built out from each bank. The other three (3) bombs scored near misses, doing no visible damage. The napalm was dropped on a nearby garden, but was a dud.

No anti-aircraft fire was encountered and all planes returned safely at 1100 (K Zone).
