

# SOLDIERS BURIED IN LEE.

## LIST OF SIX WARS IN THE THREE CEMETERIES.

### Revolutionary.

In all cases where the state is omitted Massachusetts is understood.

This list gives the names only of men whose graves are known, but it is certain that a considerable number of others are buried in town, some of whom rest in unknown graves, and the service of some others has not been traced. With the exception of Quaker, and a few other exempted, all the able-bodied men of New England between 16 and 60 were enrolled in the militia from the early years of the colonies, and during the Revolution nearly all, at one time or another, performed some military service. From first to last during that struggle the names and service of more than 120 men of Lee, or the territory incorporated into Lee in 1777, is given in the compilation, "Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors of the Revolutionary War." The service of some is given in days, some in weeks and months, and a few in years. Those marked with an asterisk were residents of Lee at the time of service.
