

- Register on Commons to take part You have to be registered on Wikimedia Commons to enter the competition. www.commons.wikimedia.org
- Enter your photos! Use the Upload Wizard to enter your photographs. Scan the QR code below to go to the upload page.



- Media can only be entered during October and November 2014. However, the media can have been created at any time; e.g. historic photographs can be entered as long as you own the copyright.
- All entries will have the following licence: Creative Commons Attribution-Share Alike 4.0 (CC-BY-SA 4.0).
- All eligible pictures must be categorised under Wiki Loves Africa 2014. This is assigned during the upload process.
- Participants must register on Wikimedia Commons, and enable e-mail, to be eligible for prizes.
