- Launched October 2012
- An interlinked database representing “the sum of all human knowledge”
- Centralising key data about “items”
- Serving data to other Wikimedia projects
- Serving machine-readable data to third parties
- MediaWiki extension (“WikiBase”)
- Fifth most active Wikimedia project!



# Using Wikidata in other projects

- Show a statement value from the current page's item in Wikipedia etc.
- parser function `{{#property:PROPERTY}}`
- scripts Lua mw.wikibase
- Usually “hidden away” in transcluded templates
- Popular on smaller Wikipedias

# Metrics

- As of February 2014
- 14 million items (English Wikipedia: <4.5M articles)
- 30 million statements
  - 20 million item references
  - 8 million strings
  - 1 million dates
  - 1 million coordinates
  - 20K quantities (those are new...)



# WikiData API

- Extension of MediaWiki API
- Full-“text” search
- Request all statements/labels/links etc. for individual items
- Editing via API
- OAuth bindings
- No queries for statements => items!

# The Wikidata tools ecosystem

# WikiData Query

- Stand-alone WikiData query server
- Uses data dumps and Recent Changes, updated every 10 minutes
- Keeps all item-to-item links, strings, times, locations in RAM
- Can be queried over HTTP, returns JSON



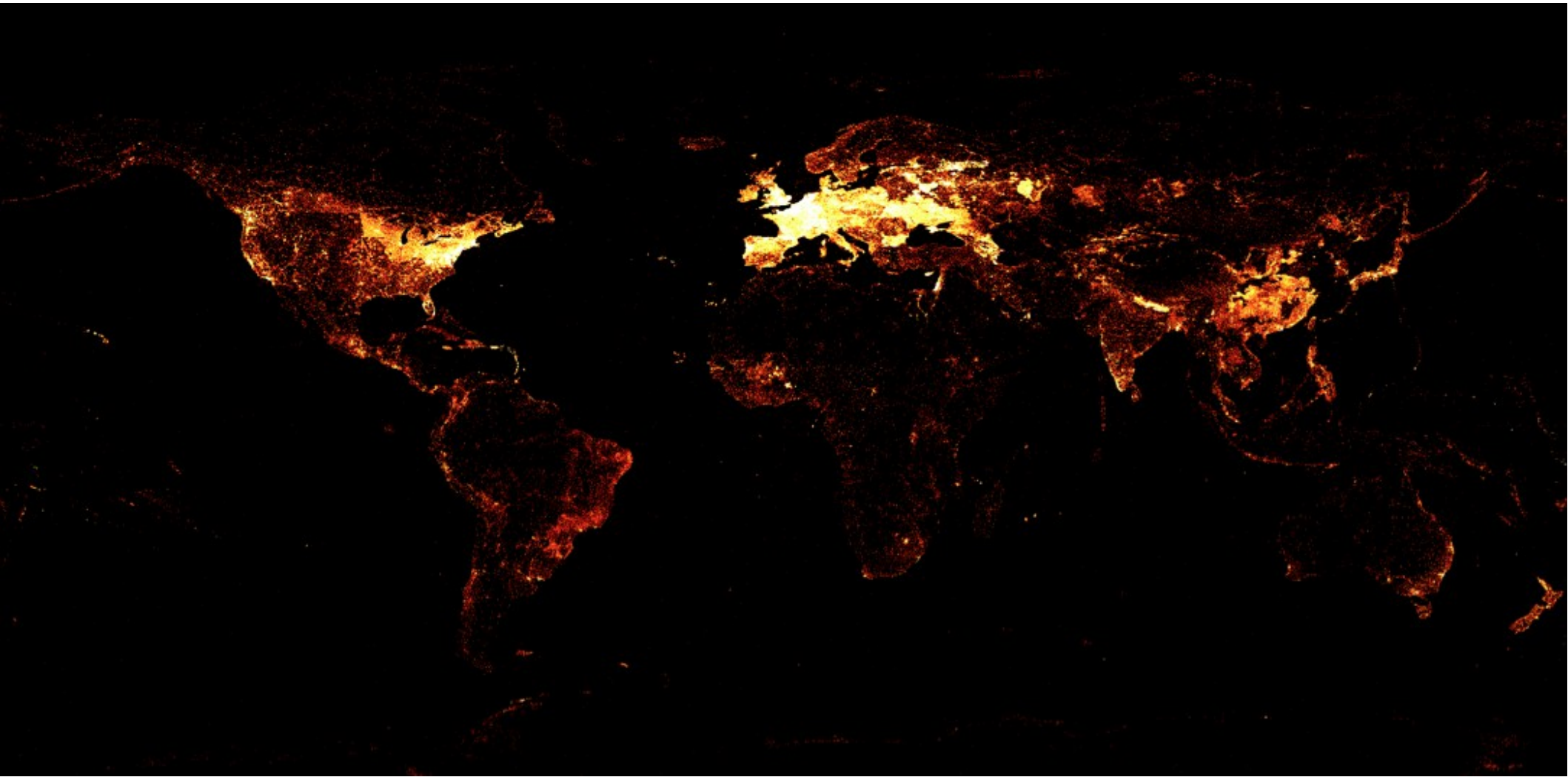
