**AN ACT**

To extend by two years the Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards Program of the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Chemical Facility Anti-  
5 Terrorism Standards Program Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF CHEMICAL FACILITY ANTI-TER-**  
2 **RORISM STANDARDS PROGRAM OF THE DE-**  
3 **PARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY.**

4 Section 5 of the Protecting and Securing Chemical  
5 Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2014 (Public Law  
6 113–254; 6 U.S.C. 621 note) is amended by striking “4  
7 years” and inserting “6 years”.
