Lineage and Honors

340th REGIMENT

Constituted 5 August 1917 in the National Army as the 340th Infantry, an element of the 85th Division

Organized 1n August-September 1917 at Camp Custer, Michigan

Demobilized 21 April 1919 at Camp Custer, Michigan

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as an element of the 85th Division

Organized in November 1921 at Saginaw, Michigan

Relieved 30 January 1942 from assignment to the 85th Division; concurrently, allotted to the Army of the United States as an inactive unit

Disbanded 4 August 1952

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reconstituted 5 May 1959 in the Army Reserve as the 340th Regiment (Advanced Individual Training), an element of the 85th Division (Training); concurrently, reorganized as follows:

Regimental Headquarters and Headquarters Company; Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions; and Companies A, B, and C, 340th Infantry retained as corresponding elements of the 340th Regiment (Advanced Individual Training)

Elements D through M, 340th Regiment (Advanced Individual Training) organized from existing or new units as follows:

340th REGIMENT

Regiment activated 1 June 1959 with Headquarters at Chicago, Illinois

Reorganized 31 January 1968 to consist of the 1st Battalion (Advanced Individual Training) and the 2d and 3d Battalions (Basic Combat Training), elements of the 85th Division (Training) (Regimental Headquarters concurrently inactivated at Chicago, Illinois)

Reorganized 1 May 1971 to consist of the 1st Battalion (Combat Support Training) and the 2d and 3d Battalions (Basic Combat Training), elements of the 85th Division (Training)


