


HOW TO GET HERE

- ◆ From Hwy 17 South, take Colonial Parkway toward Williamsburg to Cheatham Annex exit.











Relax in our Farmhouse or a townhome on the river






RV & primitive camping

King's Creek Campground features 19 RV sites;

10 overlook the water and the rest line the golf course.



Each site has water, sewer. electric and cable TV hookups, as well as a grill and picnic table. The RV bathhouse has showers, a TV lounge and laundry facilities.



Two fire pits (wood provided) and two pavilions are available for guest use.



RV reservations are accepted up to six months in advance by calling (757) 887-7224.




Want to rough it?

There are five primitive camping sites near the colonial-era Jones Mill Pond. Open spring through fall, each Jones Pond campsite has a picnic table, grill, fire pit and potable water. A bathhouse is available as well. Reservations (757) 887-7418.

Two group camping areas, ideal for scouts, are available at the Walt Fuerer Youth Pond and Area 284.



Accommodating up to 100 campers, each area has a covered pavilion, separate bath facilities, picnic tables and grills.

Cheatham Annex, surrounded by wetlands, is home to many creatures from those a-wing to those a-hoof. Cyclists, walkers and joggers will see an array of raptors overhead as bald eagles, hawks and ospreys fly the CAX skies. Spring and summer guests are treated to the osprey brooding season. Deer, turkey, raccoons and river otters are just a few of the other species guests may encounter on the base. A nature trail around Cheatham Lake offers an opportunity for guests to see some of our shier residents.



Colfing

Deer Cove Golf Course, which is nestled between the York River and King's Creek, offers a sporty 18-hole experience for veteran and novice golfers alike.

Fishing & Boating









- △ CAX guests may rent jon boats to fish the three lakes.
- △ Live bait, tackle and ice may be purchased from Outdoor Recreation.
- **△ Large mouth bass and crappie are the freshwater trophies of choice.**
- △ Annual and temporary licenses may be purchased at Outdoor Recreation.
- △ With the purchase of a one year Cheatham Annex Sportsman's Pass, anglers may fish from the saltwater supply pier where striped bass, croaker, spot, flounder, crab and a myriad of other species frequent the York River.
