P R E F A C E.

THE main features of this First Edition of the Register are, a complete list of all Members of the School from its foundation to the present time, and a list of Honours gained by Old Fettesians. Lists of the Heads of the School and of the Elevens, Fifteens, and Eights have also been added. It has been the Editor's desire to avoid over-loading the First Edition. Others will follow at suitable intervals, and it is hoped that the Second Edition may, by means of additions and corrections, be made much more valuable than the First. The Editor takes this opportunity of thanking those who kindly assisted him in his task ; he earnestly invites all Old Fettesians and others to send him any corrections or suggestions for additions which may occur to them, and he asks indulgence for any inaccuracies that may be found in the book. The labour and difficulty of compilation has been very considerable, but it is hoped that, a start once made, the record will be easily maintained for future years.

It is impossible here not to allude to the melancholy

death of Dr Potts since the proof sheets of this Register were out. By a sad coincidence the death of the first Head Master corresponds with the first publication of an official record of his work. The final proofs of these lists were lying on his table for correction when he was seized with the illness which so rapidly ended his life.

THE FOUNDER.

THE FETTES ENDOWMENT, with its College on the lands of Comely Bank, near Edinburgh, owes its existence to the benevolence of the late SIR WILLIAM FETTES of Comely Bank, Baronet.

Sir William was born in Edinburgh on the 25th of June 1750.

In 1758 and 1759 he attended at the High School of Edinburgh the class taught by Mr John Gilchrist. At the early age of eighteen he commenced business as a wine and tea merchant in Smith's Land, High Street, which occupation he combined for twenty years with that of an underwriter, besides being connected in trade with establishments at Newcastle, Durham, and Leeds. He was also for many years a contractor for military stores; and in 1800 was chosen a director of the British Linen Company Bank, in which he ultimately held stock to a large amount. He had in the meantime entered the Town Council of Edinburgh, in which he filled in 1785, the office of Fourth Bailie, and in 1799 that of First Bailie.

In 1800 he was unanimously elected Lord Provost of the City, which office he held for what was then the usual period of two years, and he held the same office for a second time in 1805 and 1806.

In 1804, between the two occasions of his occupying the Municipal Chair, he was created a Baronet.

In 1787, Sir William (then Mr) Fettes married Maria, daughter of Dr John Malcolm, Physician in Ayr. The only child of the marriage was a son William, born 31st December 1787, who in 1810 was admitted a member of the Faculty of Advocates, in which profession his high talents and estimable character gave promise of future eminence, unfortunately disappointed by his death, at Berlin, on the 13th of June 1815.

Sir William Fettes retired from business in 1800 and afterwards devoted himself to the management of landed estates which he purchased at different times in various parts of Scotland.

He died on the 27th May 1836, Lady Fettes having predeceased him on the 7th of the same month.

By his trust-disposition and settlement, dated 5th July 1830, and several codicils thereto, the last being dated 9th March 1836, he disposed his whole estates, heritable and movable, to and in favour of Lady Fettes, his sister (Mrs Bruce), Thomas Corrie, Esq., manager of the British Linen Company, Alexander Wood, Esq., Advocate (afterwards Lord Wood), and Andrew Rutherford, Esq., Advocate (afterwards Lord Rutherford), as Trustees. The purposes of the trust, which made adequate provision for Lady Fettes in case of her survivance, being (1) The payment of Legacies and of Annuities to various relations and poor dependants; (2) Bequests to Charitable Institutions, and (3) The application of the residue to "form an endowment for

the maintenance, education, and outfit of young people whose parents have either died without leaving sufficient funds for that purpose, or who, from innocent misfortune during their own lives, are unable to give suitable education to their children."

The trust-funds which, at the time of Sir William Fettes' death, amounted to about £166,000, were allowed to accumulate for a number of years, until they reached such an amount as would, in the opinion of the trustees, enable them to carry his benevolent intention into effect in a becoming manner.

In 1864, contracts were entered into for the erection of "Fettes College" according to a design prepared by David Bryce, Esq., R.S.A. The College was opened along with one Boarding House—Glencorse (*now Moredun*) House—to accommodate thirty-four boarders, on 5th October 1870, with forty Foundationers, eleven Boarding-House Pupils, and one Day Boarder. Since then Carrington House, to accommodate thirty-five Boarders, and Glencorse House, to accommodate sixty Boarders, have been added, also Kimmerghame House (Nos. 4, 5, and 6 Moredun Crescent) which has now been enlarged to accommodate twenty-five Boarders.


