After seeing the announcement of President Yeltsin's invitation for you to visit Moscow, I thought you might enjoy reading my interview with NATINA Yeltsin. (I had asked a lawyer-friend of mine to send it to you, but I don't know if it ever reached you).

I met Mrs Yeltsin while interpreting for her and Mrs

Barbara Bush when the Yeltins came to Washington in June of 1992. Mrs Yeltin was most cordial and asked me to visit her when I was in Moscow. She is a delightful woman and a good friend of the US. I think you will enjoy meeting her.

In the last paragraph there is a mention of her desire to set up a dental clinic for children. It seems as if it will be possible thanks to Ambassador Armitage's efforts to find the necessary equipment. Maybe on your visit to Moscow, you will be able to open the clinic. I will do everything I can to also pursue this.
