Chapter / Affiliate



- The formal targets of the affiliate are written down in the founding papers (the regulations or the articles of association)
- More detailed information can mostly be found in additional documents (by laws)
- The Chapters Agreement establishes the relation with WMF

Regulations / bylaws



- Active voting right for members of the organization or co-optation
- Potential board members must comply with national law and the rules or terms laid down in the regulations
- These rules have been drawn up to ensure continuity (also in times of conflict)

Board responsibility



- To lead and govern the organization
- There is a large difference between organizations with or without paid staff members

Areas of board responsibility



- Strategic leadership
- Financial management and fundraising
- Communications
- Program management
- Partnerships
- Staff management
- Governance & compliance

Strategic leadership



- Align different visions on the future
- Identify opportunities and threats
- Care for continuity in a changing environment
- From vision to action > program management

Financial management



- Income
 - Fundraising
 - Grant applications
- Expenses
- Assets and liabilities

Communication



- Essentials:
 - The message
 - The image of the sender
 - The target groups:
 - Internal: users, readers, members, other affiliates
 - External: partners, institutions.

Program management



- Governing the two sided sword:
 - Content > what
 - Community > who
- Partnerships
- Program management ≠ project management

Staff management



- CEO
- Staff members, possible areas:
 - Community affairs
 - Support for content projects
 - Partnerships
 - Communication
 - Finance & administration
- Who is reporting to who?

Governance and compliance



- Setting targets and reporting results
- Financial reporting
- Preparation of board meetings, General Assembly etc.

- Division of tasks and responsibilities between board and staff

Competencies of board members



There is a difference between:

- Skills:
 - Financial skills, HRM practice, legal knowledge, educational skills, etc.
- Competences
 - Collaboration, networking, creativity, integrity, analytical ability, etc

Annex: WMF



- WMF = Board of trustees (+ important committees such as the FDC and Affcom)
- WMF = Staff (technical, community affairs, etc)
- Relation WMF – Affiliate
 - Formal relation ship = Chapters Agreement
 - Financial relation = (Annual) grants process
 - Operational relation = conferences, services to help each other
