**GLORIOUS VICTORY OVER THE FRENCH**

**T**HE following heads of Intelligence have been received by the Honorable Company's Cruizer Psyche which arrived last night.

The Pylades sloop of war had arrived at Smyrna from Malta with letters dated 4th November, mentioning that an official account had appeared at Malta of a battle having taken place between the French under General Massena and the Allied forces under Lord Wellington, on the 27th September. Massena attacked Lord Wellington at 4½ A. M. on that day. The action lasted till five P. M. and ended in the defeat of the French. Other accounts, not official, state, that Massena had renewed the attack on the 28th, 29th and 30th and been again entirely defeated.

The French are said to have lost 6000 men in the action of the 27th and 22,000 in the succeeding engagements. Letters from Constantinople of the 22d Nov. mention, that Bernadotte, after his election as Prince of Sweden, had demanded of Russia the restitution of Finland; and that Latour Maubourg the French Resident at Constantinople had actually advised the Porte to continue the war against the Russians, who had taken Rudschuck and Gingiara. The Grand Vizier was at Shumla with the army

It is said the King of Prussia has abdicated the throne in favor of Berthier.

A Royal Salute has been fired on the occasion.
