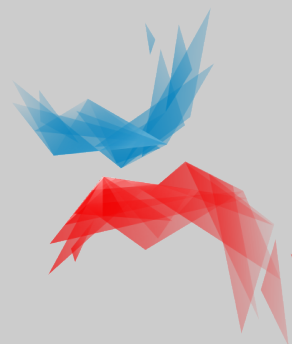

32k articles, 177k edits
6 active editors

50k articles, 1.6 M edits
90 active editors

Focus on Breton Wikipedia

For its tenth anniversary in June 2014, it just passed the 50,000-article milestone.



71st Wikipedia according to the number of articles.
67th rank for edits.

33 edits/article on average (equivalent to Catalan or Polish).

Wikipedia for the Breton language

By far, the largest website in Breton language.

Wikipedia is a main resource for both information and education.



Breton is little in Wikimedian world, but Wikipedia is huge for Breton world.

Breton Wikipedia: the community

In small communities, each one is important for the project.

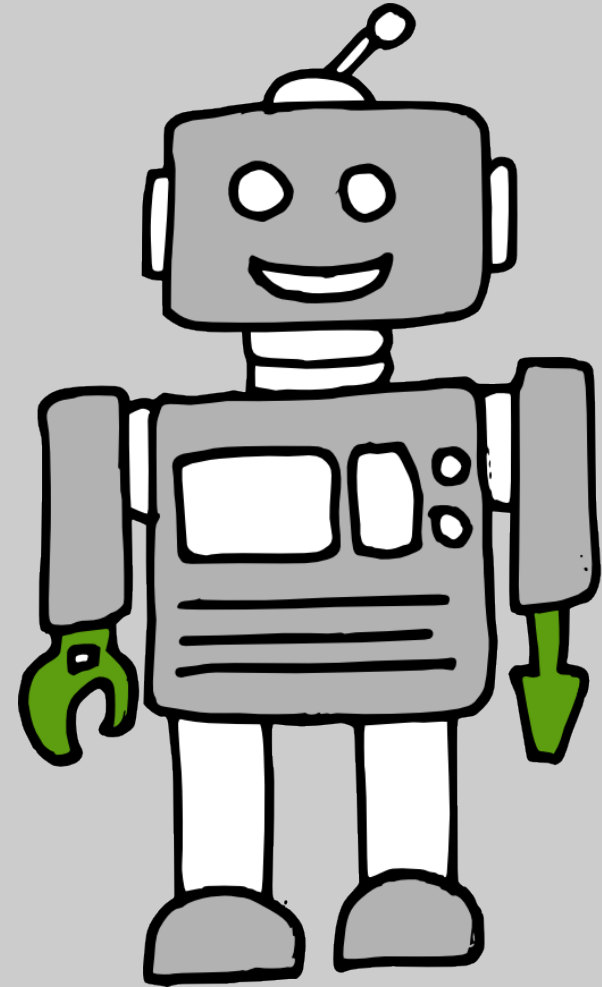
Major contributors are not involved in global movement... and may reject evolutions (Wikidata, VisualEditor...).



Keypoints for the future
