Vital Signs: The Editor Model

Acquisition - Activation - Retention

Newly Registered User - Acquisition count of users registering on given day

Rolling New Active Editor - Activation registered and 5+ edits in last 30 days

Rolling Surviving New Active Editor - Short term retention registered and made 5+ edits 30-60 days ago and made 5+ edits in last 30 days


