MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE:

SANACC 12/17, entitled "Liquidation of the Activities of the State-Army-Navy-Air Force Coordinating Committee", and approved by the Committee on June 30, contains a recommendation that the U.S. Team appointed by SANA-6368 continue to operate "under the general supervision of the Departments of State and Defense". In view of the dissolution of SANACC, effective June 30, 1949, it is suggested that all matters concerning the U.S. Team be taken up with Mr. Theodore Achilles (State Department, Extension 5525), who is acting for the Steering Member, Mr. John D. Hickerson, in the latter's absence.
