SUBJECT: False Certificates by Japanese Officials

TO : Commanding Officer
 Kinki Military Government Region
 APO 301

1. It is desired to bring to the attention of higher headquarters that a large number of false certificates pertaining to American citizenship have been stamped during the past 18 months by various Japanese officials and presented to American Consulate Offices in Kobe or Yokohama. This practice has been explained in various indorsements to communications originating in the Consular Offices.

2. Intensive efforts have been made by this team to publicize the possible serious consequences of such action by Japanese officials. The inclosure is a translation of the Wakayama Kenpo of 14 October 1948, which is an official directive of Wakayama Prefecture.

3. If such a situation exists in other prefectures to the degree that it exists in Wakayama Prefecture, it is believed that the central government should take some action to notify all public officials that such practice is of a very serious nature and may result in a sentence of up to 10 years imprisonment at hard labor for the official permitting his seal to be used.

4. The information in inclosure was furnished the local government by this headquarters.

TO : Chiefs of Local Offices and Mayors

RE : Certificates issued by Public Officers
by order of Vice Governor

It is requested all officers will pay fullest attention with the matters mentioned below when they shall issue any sort of certificates.

(1) Certificates which are to be used for regaining citizenship are to be issued by the Attorney General Bureau only but no others.

(2) Certificates related to U.S. citizenship (such as that the person voted for election or not, and the person enlisted to Military or no) are considered to be very important thing as it makes a part of evidence for deciding the person whether he or she has the U. S. citizenship or not. When officials shall be requested this kind of certificate, he must investigate fully before it is issued and shall never issue a false certificate.

(3) If a Public Official put his seal on a false certificate which is to be passed through the Occupation Forces knowingly, may be punished by hard labor not exceeding five years or fine not over ¥75,000 or both.


