I. 1,000 FOW's (British 215, Americans, 25, Dutch (including Eurasions) 760) in Macassar are schoduled to arrive in Japan on board the "Asama-Maru" due to arrive at NACASAKI on the 23rd of October. The SASTHO Naval Section shall receive them at the Pier at NAGASAKI, and deliver them to the Army (shall notify you of the date and hour) of delivery as soon as same becomes ascertained).

Furthermore, it is desired that the above-said TOWs shall be used en blec for work at KOYAKIJIMA Dockyard at NAGASAKI. Should like to receive notification from the Army Liaison Unit regarding details concerning the receiving of the TOWs. The Naval Liaison office is the SASTHO Naval Station.

II. The factories under the charge of the Navy. The Kabushihi Kaisha Osaka Dockyard in Osaka Trefecture.
