




- Non-profit charitable organization

- NL: 6 million page views per day, >1.800.000 articles









Notability

- * Significant coverage: no original research needed to create article
- * Reliable: publisher/editorial integrity
- * Sources: preferably secondary sources (e.g. review articles)
- * Independent of the subject: no press releases, advertising, autobiographies
- * Presumed: Even if above applies, a topic might still not deserve an article

Citations permit readers to put claims to the t consulting earlier works. Authors often engage earlier work directly, explaining why they agree with, or differ from, earlier views, Ideally, sources are primary (first-hand) and recent.
