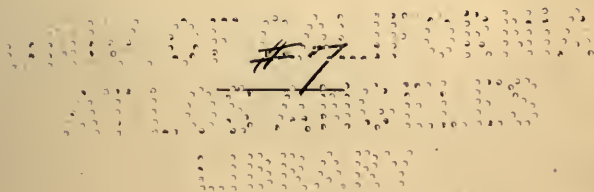




S is joined to curves in the same direction as the curve:

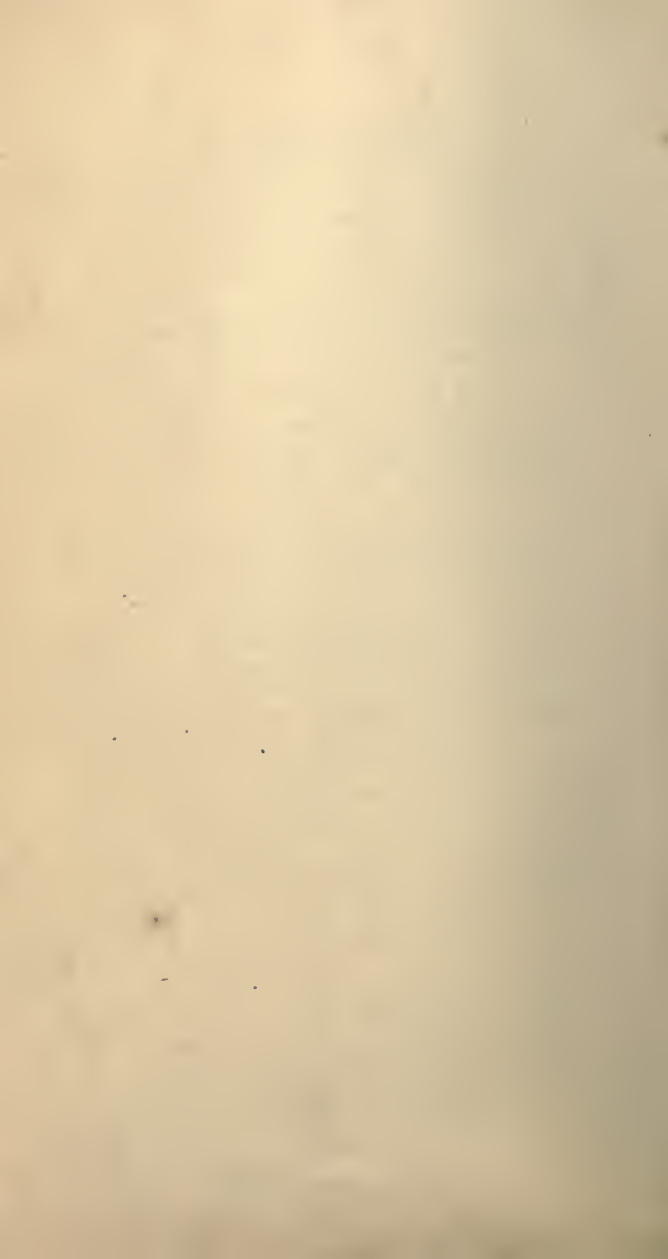
