SUMMARY OF EXAMINATION of PYARAY MOHAN,  
Clerk in Supply Department.

Address: School Lines Village, Port Blair.

Duly affirmed states:

I am 43 years of age, of Indian nationality and born at Port Blair. My permanent home is School Lines Village where I am now living.

I was arrested in a spy case on approx. 25 Jan. 43 and brought to jail where I was tortured. Six Japanese, who I do not know first gave me about 100 lashes with a cane till I was unconscious. I came to after about half an hour; they led me to a bed and then poured about five buckets of water into my nose. I again became unconscious for about 6 hours. SEAMAN SUEO ZUIA whom I could recognize was present and I heard him ordering the Japanese to torture me.
